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To the Honorable A.V. Barker, President Judge of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of the Peace of Cambria County:-

The petition of the Manufacturers' Water Company respectfully represents:

1.- Your petitioner is a corporation organized under the Act of 29th April, 1874 and its supplements, for the supply of water and water power for commercial and manufacturing purposes.

2.- That it has located one of its reservoirs upon Hinckston's Run in East Taylor and West Taylor Townships in said County at a point about 3.3 miles from where said Run empties into the Conemaugh River, and has appropriated the land which will be occupied, covered and flooded by said reservoir.

3.- Your petitioner has found it necessary in providing for such a storage and supply of water to occupy and flow with water a portion of a certain public road, situate in East Taylor Township leading from the Borough of Rosedale to Vinco; that a portion of said public road to be occupied as aforesaid is thus described by courses and distances: BEGIN-

NING At a post in the center of the road 600 feet below the center line of the breast of the dam of The Manufacturers' Water Company; thence north, 16 degrees, 50 minutes east, 260 feet; north, 11 degrees, 3 minutes east, 413 feet; north, 23 degrees, 33 minutes east, 1522 feet; north, 31 degrees, 5 minutes east, 382 feet; north, 14 degrees, 42 minutes east, 284 feet; north, 5 degrees, 21 minutes west, 266 feet; north, 12 degrees, 41 minutes west, 69 feet; north, 2 degrees, 42 minutes east, 173 feet; north, 19 degrees, 23 minutes east, 105 feet; north, 4 degrees, 32 minutes west, 200 feet, and thence north 21 degrees, 47 minutes east, 107 feet to a point near the bridge crossing Hinckston's Run.

4.- Your petitioner desires to forthwith reconstruct said road at its own proper expense on a favorable location and in as perfect a manner as the original road, which said sup-

plied and reconstructed road begins at a post in said road distant 600 feet below the center line of the dam of your petitioner; thence north, 39 degrees, 50 minutes east, 639 feet; north, 6 degrees, 14 minutes west, 193 feet; north, 26 degrees, 46 minutes east, 234.4 feet; north, 31 degrees, 51 minutes east, 216.2 feet; north, 31 degrees, 20 minutes east, 214.6

feet; north, 40 degrees, 18 minutes east, 302.1 feet; north, 50 degrees, 27 minutes east, 170 feet; north, 63 degrees, 31 minutes east, 149.7 feet; east, 148 feet; north, 31 degrees, 11 minutes east, 136 feet; north, 44 degrees, 2 minutes west, 90 feet; north, 25 degrees, 34 minutes west, 127 feet; north, 7 degrees, 52 minutes east, 223.6 feet; north, 32 degrees, 49 minutes east, 306.2 feet; north, 20 degrees east, 220 feet; north, 1 degree, 32 minutes west, 355 feet; and thence north, 10 degrees, 27 minutes west, 609 feet to a point on the original road which is 304 feet above the bridge crossing Hinckston's Run. The maximum grade of the road to be thus reconstructed is *three (3) degrees* ~~three (3) degrees~~ *and the location thereof is the most favorable of which the topography of the country will admit.*

5. Your petitioner further represents that the land through which said road is now laid out and through which it is to be reconstructed is owned partly by your petitioner and partly by Cambria Iron Company, with which latter Company amicable arrangements have been made for the taking of its land necessary for the reconstruction of said road.

6.- A draft of said roads is hereto annexed, which draft has been prepared from actual surveys and upon which the portion of said road occupied by the reservoir of your petitioner is colored green, and the road to be reconstructed to supply said portion is colored red.

Your petitioner, therefore, prays your Honorable Court to approve the location of said road to be reconstructed as aforesaid, and it will ever pray, &c.
