The undersigned, viewers named in the within order respectfully report:

1. That we met at the time and place specified in the notices, to-wit: on the thirtieth day of August, 1904, at the dwelling house of Jacob Kelley, in Adams Township, as required by the notices.

2. The notices required by law were duly given, that is to say ten days in writing to the Cambria County Commissioners, of the time and place at which the said viewers should meet to discharge the duties of their appointment, and also notice to the landowners and the public, of the time and place of such meeting, by six advertisements, put up in the most public places in the vicinity of the ground to be viewed, five days before the time fixed for holding the view. John W. Smay and Jas. D. Ross, two of the road supervisors of Adams Twp. were present at the view.

3. We were severally affirmed according to law, and before proceeding to discharge our duties.

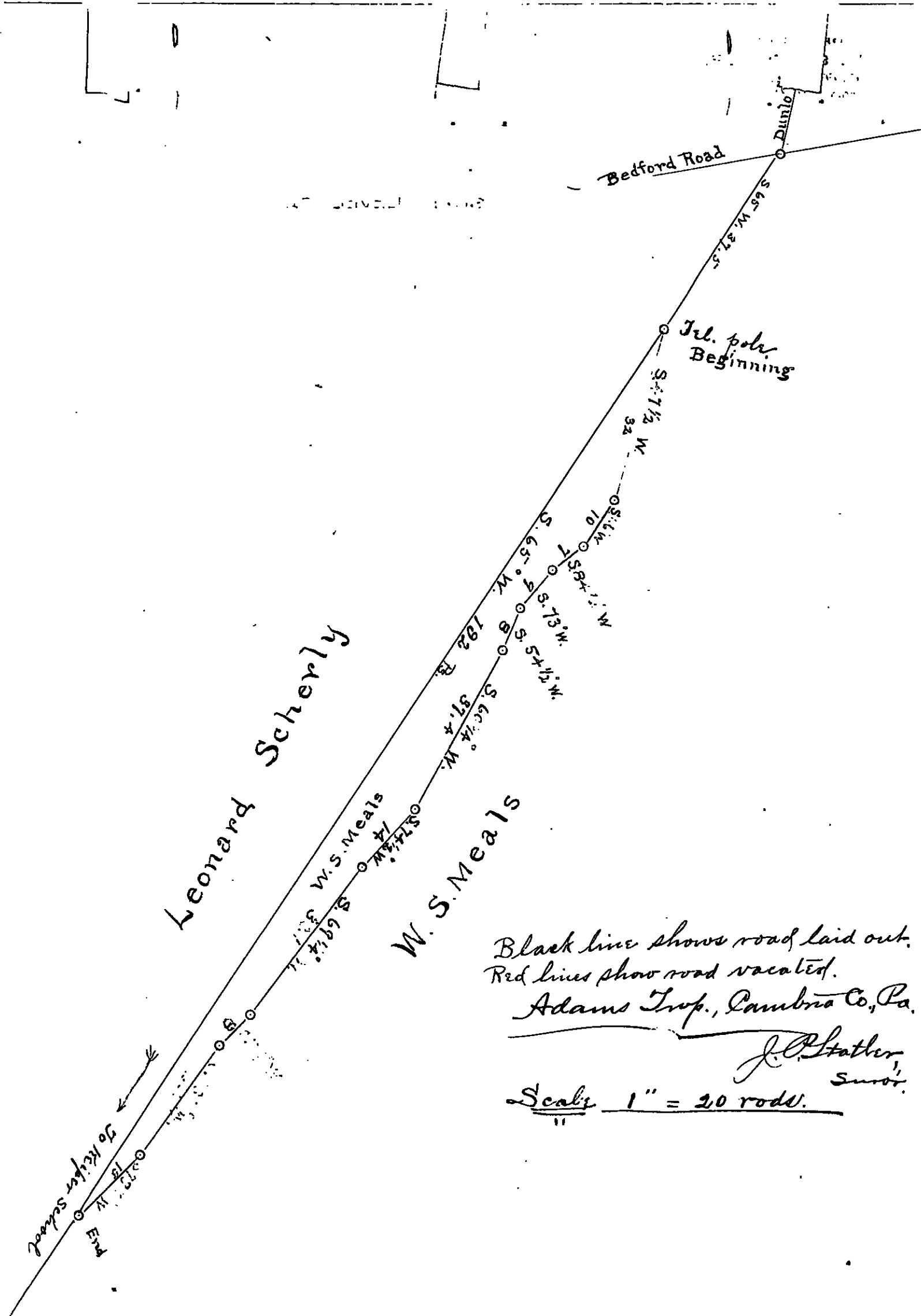
4. We viewed the site and locality of the road proposed to be vacated and laid out, making a personal inspection of the ground between the points designated in the petition and order on the 30, day of August, 1904.

5. We are of the opinion and agree that the public road leading from the Bedford Road to Keiper school house, beginning at a telegraph pole S. 63° W., thirty-seven and five tenths perches from center of Bedford Road at the intersection of the public road to Dunlo; thence through woodland of W. S. Meals, S. $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., thirty-two perches; S. 66° W., ten perches; S. $84\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., seven perches; S. 73° W., nine perches; S. $54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., eight perches; S. $60\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W. thirty-seven and four tenths perches; S. $74\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., fourteen perches; S. $69\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., thirty-three and six tenths

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg in the said County, on the Second day of August A. D. 190 4, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Adams, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience ~~for want of a public road leading from the Bedford County line to the Keiper School House~~ by reason of a bend in a public road, in said township, which is hereafter described, and which they desire vacated and another laid out instead. They pray that the public road, See Road Docket Vol. page , or that part of a public road which leads from the Bedford Road to the Keiper School House, should be vacated for a distance of about thirty one hundred feet from a point west, about six hundred and seventy-five from point where above described road intersects with the road which leads from Bedford County to Elton, Cambria County, on land line between Scherley and Meals (formerly Hofecker) farm; to a point in the public road near the dwelling house of Jacob Kelly; all within Adams Township, Cambria County, Pa and a new road laid out from same point to the same point in a straight direction along the land line of the Scherly and Meals farm and the large bend and curves in the present road thus removed.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to ^{vacate} view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Jno. P. Statler SURVEYOR, and

Sylvester Reynolds and Lester Hutzler

VIEWS, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

MOUNTAINEER-REXALD PRINT.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report, at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: first, who of them were present at the view; second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
