Whereas, sundry inhabitants of Reade township, have petitioned the Court, to appoint viewers, to view and lay out a public road, as above set

forth; KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, John B. Kruis of White township, Cambria County Pa. principal, and Harry W. Gates and G. M. Gates of said township, and county, are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the use of Cambria County, in the sum of One hundred dollars, lawful money of the United States, to which payment well and truly to be made and done, we do bind ourselves, jointly and severally, our, and each of our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of June A.D. 1908

THE CONDITIONS OF THIS OBLIGATION, are such. That whereas, the above recited petition has been filed for, and viewers appointed, to view and make report thereon to the Court.

Therefore: We said principal and sureties, agree to re-pay and re-imburse said County of Cambria for all such moneys as it shall have paid out, as compensation under the law, for the services of said viewers and fees for the said Court officers, when said road view shall have been concluded, as provided by the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided.

And upon such payment having been made, this bond to become null and void, or else, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

The portion thereof in Clearfield County not having been opened in pursuance of said opening order, issued out of the said Court of Clearfield County, wherein said road was to be intersected by a road, "shortly to be laid out in Cambria County" .

The two views forming a direct and connected road between the points of beginning and termini mentioned in the said Order to view hereto attached.

Your viewers attach hereto and make it a part of this report, a map of draft of said road, showing the improved lands, and woodlands, from the point of beginning, to the point where it crosses the Clearfield and Cambria County line.

Norman Lithgow, the owner of the lands through which said portion in Cambria County passes claimed damages, and your viewers have awarded to him the sum of Fifty Dollars for his damages by reason of the opening of said road to the Clearfield County line.

Which said road, so as aforesaid laid out to the point of intersection with the Clearfield County line, we are of opinion is necessary for a public road.

We the undersigned, appointed by the annexed order, respectfully report: That having given due and lawful notice of the time and place of meeting of viewers, by printed notices posted in conspicuous public places in the vicinity of said view, as shown by the copy thereof hereunto annexed, and notice served upon the County Commissioners as shown by copy thereof hereunto annexed, and notice to the Supervisors of the proper township, hereunto annexed, all of which are made a part of this report.

That having all been present, at the view of the ground for the proposed road, in said order mentioned, and having all been first severally sworn, we have, in pursuance of the said order, viewed the ground proposed for said road, have viewed and laid out, and do return for public use the following road to wit:

Beginning at a point on another public road leading from Jack Gallaher's to Glasgow, at or near the residence of Norman Lithgow in Reade township Cambria County; thence North 86 deg. 30 min. East a distance of 372 feet to a post; being through improved lands of said Norman Lithgow; thence North 24 deg. 30 min. East a distance of 501 feet to a post; thence North 28 deg. East through woods on lands of said Lithgow a distance of 172 feet; thence still on lands of said Lithgow, North 38 deg. 45 min. East a distance of 190 feet to a post; thence still on said lands, through woods, North 36 deg. East a distance of 250 feet to a post; thence still through said lands, North 38 deg. East, a distance of 195 feet to a post; thence still on said lands, North 40 deg. viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
