



I further think that it would be a great benefit for the people in Sewedtown

John Simmelsberger called and sworn who testifies as follows:

I have been getting out of my place by fighting and throughing down poles that have been rut across the road. My children go to shall by way of this private road. There are six farmers on this road. the same as named by the former witnesses. This road would be an accommodation to the people of Sweedtown in my opinion, to get from Sweedton to Boniface they have to tresspass on other property or go around by way to Hastings which is at least a mile farther.

Counsel for the road offers in evidence the notice attached to the report of view ers showing the actions of the test notice giving the time and place of view by Harry Thomas. We also offer the affidavit of Christ Otto as Supervisor of Flder Township for the purpose of showing the date of his being sworn into office.
