PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS
OF CAMBRIA COUNTY:

We, the undersigned, having been appointed by the Court to inspect the bridge recently erected by Cambria County across the Blacklick at or near Griffith's mill on the road leading from Nicktown to Ebensburg, in Barr Township, after having been severally sworn, state that we have attended to the duties of the appointment, and beg to report as follows:

That having examined the bridge and abutments, we find it to be erected according to the ^{contract} plans and specifications, and in a workman-like manner, ^{and we do hereby approve the same.} and recommend that the contractors, Murphy & Applesby be allowed for extra work done on the wing walls of the above bridge, _____ yards at \$ _____ per yard.

To the Honorable Francis J. O'Connor, President Judge
of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Penn'a.

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the
Township of Richland, in the County of Cambria and State
of Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

That they labor under great inconvenience for want
of a public road to begin at a point on a public road in
the Township of Richland, County of Cambria and State of
Pennsylvania, leading from the Scalp Level Turnpike to
Windber, in the County of Somerset and State of Pennsyl-
vania, where the same crosses Stanter Run, in the said
Township of Richland, County of Cambria, and State afore-
said; thence in a southerly direction, through the lands
of Samuel Hoffman, a distance of about two hundred feet,
and ending at a point in said public road, about two
hundred twenty-five rods distant, in a northerly direction,
from where the Somerset and Cambria County line, crosses
said public road.

Your petitioners, therefore, pray the Court to
appoint three persons, qualified according to law, to
view the ground proposed for such road, and, if they see
occasion to lay out the same, to inquire of and vacate
~~that part of a public road~~ leading from the Scalp Level
Turnpike to Windber, in Somerset County, beginning at
a point in said public road, where the same crosses
Stanter Run, in the said Township of Richland, County of
Cambria and State aforesaid; thence in a southerly direc-
tion, ~~across the steep bluff,~~ and ending at a point in said

public road, about two hundred twenty-five rods distant ,
in a northerly direction, from where the Somerset and
Cambria County line crosses said public road, in the said
Township of Richland, County of Cambria and State afore-
said; which said last mentioned road will, by reason of
the laying out of the proposed road, become useless; and
make report of their proceedings to the next term of said
Court; and they will ever pray, etc.,
