D. 190 9, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Upper Yoder, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, to lead from

a point, at the southern end of a public road, to wit: the Lower Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company turnpike, said point being at the "Octagon" House in said Township of Upper Yoder; extending in a southwesterly direction to a point at a public road in said Township, to wit: the southern end of the Hill Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company turnpike, said point being near the residence of John Keifer in the Township aforesaid, to wit: about one hundred (100) feet south of said residence.

That the point of beginning of said proposed public road, as above stated, is at the intersection of the said Lower Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company turnpike and another public road, to wit: the Davidsville Road in said Township of Upper Yoder, it being a public road leading from the southern end of the said Lower Route of the Valley Pike Company turnpike, the same being the point of beginning of the said proposed public road, in a northerly direction 1054 feet, as hereinafter given, to the Hill Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company turnpike, intersecting there with said Hill Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company turnpike, at or near the residence of Chas. Pribeck in the occupancy of Samuel Wagner, in said Township.

That the point of ending, as above stated, is 1447 feet from the northerly end of the said intersecting public road, to wit: the above mentioned Davidsville Road, a public road, extending from the beginning of the proposed road, as stated, in a northerly direction 1054 feet; to a point at or near the residence of said Chas. Your petitioners further represent that they served a notice of the presentation of this petition to the Court of Quarter Sessions of said County, upon the Supervisors of said Upper Yoder Township, a copy of which is hereto attached and made part hereof and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

# REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE FRANCIS J. O'CONNOR, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF  
THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

The undersigned road viewers named in the within order,  
respectfully report:

First. That we met at the time and place specified in  
the notices, to wit: on the 24th day of November, 1909, at 10  
o'clock A. M. at the point of beginning, to wit; at the "Octagon"  
House at or near the junction of the Davidsville Road and the  
Lower Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company Turnpike, mentioned  
in said notices, both public roads in the Township of Upper Yoder,  
and completed our labors on said date.

Second. That notices required by law were duly given,  
that is to say, written notices of the application to the Court  
of Quarter Sessions of said Cambria County, for the laying out,  
opening and constructing of said road for public use, to the  
Supervisors of the said Township of Upper Yoder, and also notice  
of the time and place of the meeting of viewers to the Supervis-  
ors of the said Township of Upper Yoder, copies of which notices  
are hereto annexed and made part of this return; that public no-  
tice by written or printed advertisements of the time and place  
where we were to meet for the purpose of locating the road was  
given at least ten(10) days before such meeting, as required by  
the Act of Assembly of the 6th day of April, 1843, P. L. 177 and  
the Act of Assembly of the 12th day of March, 1873, P. L. 258,  
copy of which notice is hereto annexed and made part of this  
return; that at least six day's notice in writing of the time and  
place of holding said view was given to the County Commissioners  
of the said County of Cambria, as required by the Act of Assembly  
of the 3rd day of April, 1899, P. L. 26, a copy of which notice



is hereto annexed and made part of this return; and that written notice was given to the Supervisors of said Township in accordance with the Act of 29th of March, 1905, P. L. 70, as shown by notice hereto attached and made part hereof.

Third. That we were severally sworn or affirmed, according to law and before proceeding to discharge our duties, which original oath or affirmation is hereto annexed and made part of this return.

Fourth. That we viewed the site and locality of the road proposed to be laid out, making a personal inspection of the ground between the points designated in the petition and order, on the 24th day of November, 1909.

Fifth. That we are of the opinion and agree that a public road between the points mentioned, is necessary, and that we authorize the laying out of a public road according to the accompanying draft.

We therefore lay out and return for public use a road as follows:

Beginning at a point the intersection of the Lower Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company Turnpike and the Davidsville Road, both Township roads in said Upper Yoder, said point of intersection being Ten hundred fifty-four (1054) feet from the intersection of said Davidsville Road and the Upper Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company Turnpike, also a public road in said Upper Yoder Township; thence south eighty-one (81) degrees thirty (30) minutes west five hundred eighty (580) feet to a point on the said Upper Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company Turnpike, which point is the junction of the proposed road and the said Upper Route of the condemned Valley Pike Company Turnpike, all of which proposed road is within the said Township of Upper Yoder as will appear on the draft hereto attached and made part

of this return.

We further report that the grade of the proposed road, to wit; ~~four and one-fourth~~  $(4\frac{1}{4})$  degrees is the lowest grade that can be had on a road between the said points of beginning and ending as herein given.

Sixth. We further report that we endeavored to obtain from all the owners of land, upon which said road is located, releases of damages to arise by reason of said location; but that we were unable to secure any such releases; all the said owners of land being S. K. Miller, Max Rex, Lucretia Carpenter and the Cambria Iron Company; and that we assessed the damages of the said S. K. Miller, the said Max Rex, the said Lucretia Carpenter and the said Cambria Iron Company at nothing, for the reason that we find that the benefits accruing to said property owners bordering on the said road fully compensate them for any loss resulting from the construction of said road.

Seventh. That in our opinion the said road laid out by us is of such public necessity and utility that the costs of this proceeding ought to be paid by the county; however, it is our recommendation that the Supervisors of the said Upper Yoder Township, when they open said road remove the fence where said proposed road occupies the fence line and replace said fence along the proper line of the said proposed road at the proper cost and expense of the said Upper Yoder Township.

Eighth. That we annex hereto the plot or draft, before referred to, showing the location of the said road laid out, stating the courses and distances and noting briefly the improvements.
