

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Township of Conemaugh and County aforesaid, respectfully represents; That they, owing to the proposed construction of a dam on the part of the Conemaugh and Franklin Water Company, labor under a great inconvenience for want of a public road to begin at a point opposite the lime shed of Jacob Custer on a public road known as

Clafford Rem Row leading to the Borough of Franklin in said Township of Conemaugh, and ending at a point on the aforesaid public road immediately opposite the residence of the Charles Umberger Estate, being a distance of fourteen hundred and one (1401) feet.

We, the undersigned, appointed by the annexed order, do report: That in pursuance thereof, after having been severally affirmed, all the Viewers appointed by said order viewed the ground for the proposed road, and the undersigned do agree that there is occasion for a road as petitioned for, and that the same is necessary for a public road; and having respect to the shortest distance and best ground we have laid out the same in such manner as to do least injury to private property, and as far as possible according to the desire of petitioners, and return for public use the following described road: Beginning at a point opposite the lime shed in public road; thence S. 49° 30' East 273.5 feet; thence by 35° 23' Left Curve 139.52 feet; thence N. 81° 8' East 175 feet; thence by 34° 24' Right Curve 113.13 feet; thence S. 59° 57' East 650 feet to a point in public road opposite residence of Charles Umberger Estate. NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
