That having examined the bridge and abutments, we find it to be erected according to the contract, plans and specifications, and in a workmanlike manner, and we do hereby approve the same and recommend that the contractor, J. A. Lord be allowed for extra work done to the wing walls on the above bridge, ~~45⁰⁰ to 45⁰⁰~~ yards, at \$ ~~per yard~~ or 45⁰⁰ in addition to the contract price.
