

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

#### REPORT OF VIEWERS

TO THE HONORABLE M. B. STEPHENS, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT OF QUATER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY:-

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers, appointed by your Honorable Court, to view the ground for a proposed public road, extending into or through a portion of each Cambria, Blacklick and Barr Townships, Cambria County, Pa. Beginning at a point on a public road connecting the road from Ebensburg to Nicktown with the road from Ebensburg to Belsano at or near the mail box of George W. Jervis, in Cambria Township and ending at a pint or fork of road leading from Belsano to Carrollton on the property of Joe Pricer, in Barr Township, known as Pricer's Railroad crossing as shown by the Ordr of Court hereto attached, respectfully report:

and place of meeting of the Viewers to the County Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of each of the three Townships above named, by having them accept service of notices, and to the public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the proposed road; All of us met in accordance with the notice given and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment, faithfully, impartially and to the best of our ability, we proceeded ro view the ground proposed for said road and are of opinion that the said road thus suggested is not necessary for a public road.

we are of opinion that a road such as the one proposed would accomodate but a very few people, most of whom already

have fairly good and convenient roads by which to reach the which would be or stand points connected by the proposed road; further that the expense of constructing and maintaining a road between the points proposed for a road would be very heavy and to our minds far in excess of what the Townships ought reasonably be expected to bear considering what little benefit the public would derive from the expenditure of the sum which it will require to construct and maintain the said road. The said road as proposed extends largely through woodland and for the most part of which is rough or low ground and where a portion of the same passes over property of the Ebensburg Coal Company, they justly claim the same would very materially interfere with their operations and refused to give a release of damages which would be sustained by them if the road as suggested were opened to the public.

A plot or draft showing the location of the proposed road and made a part of this report, which said line of the proposed road as run as near as practicable according to the desire of the petitioners, takes the following courses and distances, beginning at a point in the public road opposite the mail box of George W. & Jervis, above referred to, thence North fifteen degrees East one hundred sixty-seven feet, thence North thirty four and one fourth degrees East six hundred eight feet, thence North firve degrees East six hundred twenty-six feet through and over land of George W. Jervis and Alfred Oaks, thence through land of the Ebensburg Coal Company North three degrees East seven hundred ten feet, thence North forty-one degrees West three hundred thirty-five feet, thence North nineteen degrees West three hundred seventy-four feet, thence North forty one degrees West two hundred and eighty eight feet to

fourths degrees West twelve hundred fifty eight feet, thence North sixty seven degrees West three hundred and eighty feet, thence North forty-four degrees West sixteen hundred fifty-seven feet, thence North seventy-eight degrees West crossing the Blacklick and Yellow Creek Railroad, four hundred feet, thence North thirteen degrees West four hundred fifty seven feet and thence North five and one half degrees West two hundred sixty three feet, thence North nineteen degrees West one hundred sixty-eight feet, thence North forty-one degrees West one hundred twleve feet, thence North fifty-four and one half degrees West four hundred sixty-three feet, thence North forty-nine degrees West one thousand feet, thence through and over lands of McGuire, Lieb and others, North seventy-nine degrees West nine hundred and farty feet, thence North thirty-three degrees West eighteen hundred eigty feet to a point on the road leading from Belsano to Nicktown at a point just South of the Pricer Crossing.
