Eckenrodes Mill, part of which they desire vacated and another laid  
out instead, and praying that that part of said public road leading  
from the old Ebensburg and Carrolltown road to Bradley Junction and  
Eckenrodes Mill, in Cambria County, should be vacated from a point  
two thousand and twelve feet East of the intersection of said road  
with said old Ebensburg and Carrolltown road, to a point two thousand  
three hundred and forty-five feet East of said intersection, all  
within the Township of East Carroll, County of Cambria, Pennsylvania,  
and a new road laid out from same point to same point at a proper  
grade and curvature and thus eliminate the dangerous and inconvenient

part of the present road; and praying for the appointment of Viewers to vacate and supply the said road.

The Petition of the undersigned, residents and citizens of East Carroll Township, in said County, and vicinity, respectfully represents:

That they labor under some inconvenience by reason of the heavy grade and dangerous railroad crossing on the road leading from the Old Ebensburg and Carrolltown Road, at a point about three miles from Carrolltown, past Wolfs Mill to Bradley Junction, part of which they desire vacated and another laid out instead.

They pray that that part of said public road leading from the Old Ebensburg and Carrolltown road past Wolfs Mill to Bradley Junction, in Cambria County, should be vacated from a point one hundred and eighty feet Southwest of the point where the branch railroad from Bradley Junction to Carrolltown of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company intersects the said road, to a point three hundred and twenty feet Northeast of said point of intersection, all within the Township of East Carroll, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and a new road laid out from same point to same point at a proper grade and curvature and thus eliminate the dangerous and inconvenient part of the present road.

R E P O R T       O F       V I E W E R S

TO THE HONORABLE M. B. STEPHENS, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE  
COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY:-

We the undersigned, Members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court to view and determine as to the propriety or necessity of vacating a portion or piece of road in East Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pa. and supplying another piece of road instead thereof between the places of beginning and ending of that <sup>proposed to be</sup> portion vacated as noted in the Order of Court hereto attached, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of East Carroll Township by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the travelling public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the piece of road proposed to be vacated and supplied: All of us met in accordance with the notices so given and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability, we viewed the premises and are of opinion that a change in the road bed between these points of beginning and ending is necessary for the convenience and safety of the traveling public. A plot or draft showing the location of the piece of road now in use and also the location of the new stretch of road suggested to be opened for public use instead of that portion of road now in use, is hereto attached and made a part of this report; and shows the portion of road proposed to be vacated beginning at a point 180 feet Southwest of the Bradley Junction and Carrolltown Branch

of the Pennsylvania Railroad and ending at a point 500 feet North east of the said branch of the P. R. R. as shown on the attached draft and noted as a piece of road proposed to be vacated and the portion of road as laid out to supply the same beginning at the said point Southwest of the road crossing and running thence South 81 degrees East 387 feet and thence North fifty-five degrees forty five minutes East 390 feet to the place of ending of the piece of road proposed to be vacated.

By thus changing the location of the road bed the present steep grade on either side of the railroad will be eliminated and the traveling public will have an opportunity of crossing said railroad track at a point from which they will have an opportunity of observing the approach of trains from either direction which will be greatly to their safety and advantage.

Having failed to secure a release of damages from Casper Wolf through and over whose land the piece of road proposed to be supplied has been laid out, we have assessed his damages at forty five dollars (\$45.00).

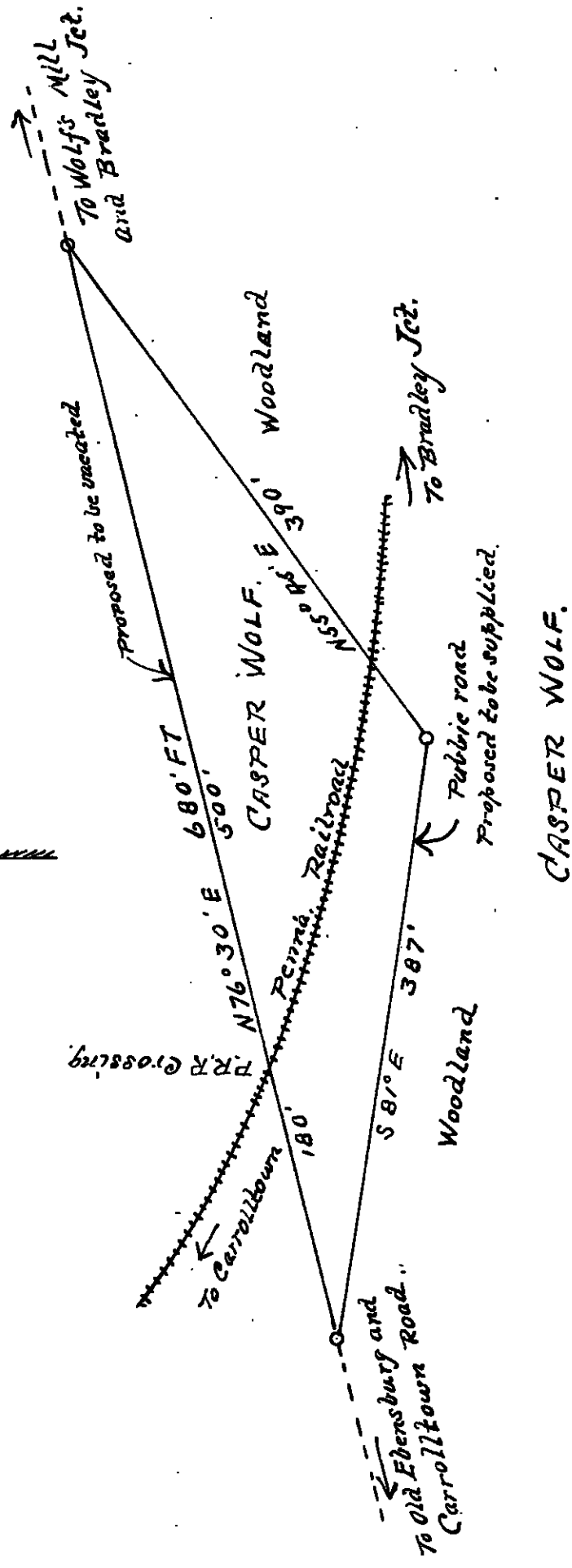

They pray that that part of said public road leading from the Old Ebensburg and Carrolltown Road past Wolf's Mill to Bradley Junction, in Cambria County, should be vacated from a point one hundred and eighty feet southwest of the point where the branch railroad from Bradley Junction to Carrolltown of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company intersects the said road, to a point three hundred and twenty feet north east of said point of intersection, all within the Township of East Carroll, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and a new road laid out from said point at a proper grade and curvature and thus eliminate the dangerous and inconvenient part of the present road.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

A. M. Shoemaker surveyor, and  
P. F. Campbell and John L. Singer

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
