REHPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE MARLIN BINGHAM STEPHENS, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY:-

We the undersigned, Members of the Boar of Viewers of Cambria County appointed by your Honorable Court to view and determine as to propriety or necessity of vacating a portion or piece of road in East Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pa. and supplying another piece of road instead thereof, between the places of beginning and ending of that portion proposed to be vacated, as noted in the Order of Court hereto attached, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of East Carroll Township by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the travelling public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminit of the piece of road proposed to be vacated and supplied; All of us met in accordance with the notices so given and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; we viewed the premises and are of opinion that a chage in the poad bed between the points of beginning and ending as noted on the attached order is necessary for the convenience of the traveling public as the grade of that portion of the road suggested to be vacated is exceedingly heavy and considerably in excess of what the law contemplates as the maximum grade on public highways where it is practicable to reduce the same.

A plot or draft showing the location of the piece of road now in use and also the location of the new stretch of road sug-

gested to be opened for public use is hereto attached and made part of this report and shows the piece of road proposed to be vacated as beginning at a point 2012 feet East of the intersection of this road with the old Ebensburg and Carrolltown road and extending thence North 21 degrees 30 minutes East 320 feet beyond the place of beginning and the piece of road as laid out and suggestto supply the portion vacated running from the point of beginning above noted North 52 degrees East 230 feet, thence North 205 feet to point of ending as shown on the plot or draft attached.

Having failed to secure a release of damages from Henry J. Buck through and over whose land the same is laid out, we have assessed his damages at fifty-six dollars.



NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
