

R E P O R T     O F     V I E W E R S .

TO THE HONORABLE M. B. STEPHENS, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE  
COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY:-

We the undersigned, Members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court to view the site and determine as to the necessity of constructing a new bridge over the South Fork Branch of the Little Conemaugh River at the place where Maple Street in the Borough of South Fork crosses the same as noted in the Order of Court hereto attached; respectfully report.

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers to the public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the site of the said bridge and to the County Commissioners and the Borough Council of the said Borough by having them accept service of like notices; all of us met at the site of the said bridge in accordance with the notices so given and having been each duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, justly, impartially and according to the best of our judgment and ability: We viewed the premises and are of opinion that a new bridge across the South Fork Branch of the Little Conemaugh at the location above noted is necessary for the convenience and accomodation of the public and that the expense of erecting a sutiable structure at this place will entail an expenditure of more than the Borough of South Fork should be required to bear alone; Therefore we suggest that the County of Cambria should bear two thirds of the expense of constructing the same and the Borough of South Fork the other third of the cost of constructing the said bridge and that the said Borough should bear the expense of constructing proper approaches to the said new bridge, the length of which we suggest should be *seventy*

five feet and the width twenty feet and that the same should be located on the line of Maple Street and that the same be built about four feet higher than the present old bridge or about thirteen feet above low water: The present old structure being in a bad state of repair and not suitable for the accomodation of the public at this point and being in such condition that it would be a useless expenditure of money to repair or raise the same.

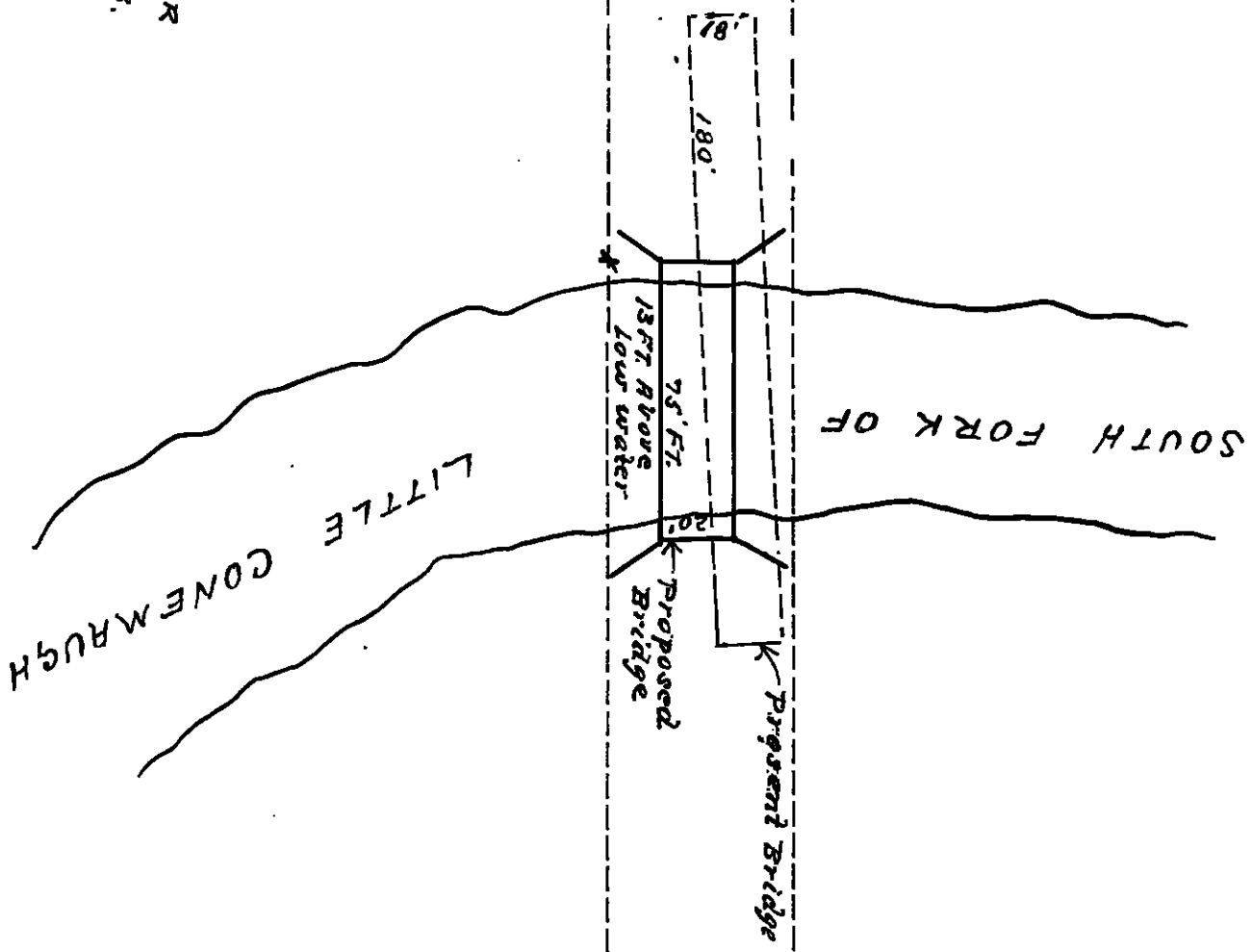
