R-E-P-O-R-T - - O-F - V-I-E-W-E-R-S

TO THE HONORABLE M. B. STEPHENS, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT
OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY:-

We, the undersigned Members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court to view the site where the Township Road leading from Loretto to Carrolltown crosses the Chest Creek, near Bradley Junction, where the said Creek divides the Townships of Carroll and Allegheny; to determine as to the necessity of erecting a new bridge across the said Chest Creek, and as to the propriety of changing the Township Road where the same would lead to the approaches of a new bridge, if the same was constructed at the most suitable place for crossing the said Creek, in traveling along the Township road between the points above referred to: as set forth in the Order of Court hereto attached, respectfully report:-

That having given due public notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers to the County Commissioners and the Supervisors of the said Townships by having them accept service of notices and to the public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the site of the said proposed new bridge and change or variation of the Township Road; All of us met at the site of the said old bridge and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, justly, impartially and to the best of our ability, we viewed the premises and are of opinion that there is occasion for a County bridge across the Chest Creek between the Townships above named where the route of the road leading between the points above referred to crosses the said Creek and further, are of opinion that a change in the Township road leading to the approaches of the proposed new bridge should be varied as follows, :-
Beginning at a point in the turn of the road near the lane of Ed.

Farbaugh in Allegheny Township and running thence North twenty degrees thirty minutes West two hundred ten feet and thence North forty-four degrees West six hundred thirty-five feet crossing Chest Creek at about one hundred and seventy-five feet from this station and said proposed new piece of road as laid out extending through and over property of the Pennsylvania Railroad Co. for about four hundred and thirty feet; from whom having failed to secure a release of damages, we estimate that they are entitled to no damages. Further we suggest that the public road as now in use between the points of beginning and ending of the proposed new piece of road, part of which extends into both Townships, should be vacated, the same beginning at the point near the lane of Ed. Farbaugh, afore-mentioned, takes the following courses and distances, North forty-five degrees West two hundred fifty-four feet, thence North twenty-seven degrees West one hundred thirty feet to a point on the old bridge, thence North five degrees and thirty-five minutes West one hundred and twenty-eight feet, thence North fifty-one degrees thirty minutes West three hundred and fifty feet to a point on the right of way of the P. R. R. Co., place of ending of the proposed new piece of road, above described; which said last noted piece of road will become useless and burdensome to the the tax payers of the Township by reason of the substitution of the new piece of road as laid out.

A plat or draft showing the proposed new location of the bridge, the proposed new piece of road as laid out, as well as the piece of road proposed to be vacated is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

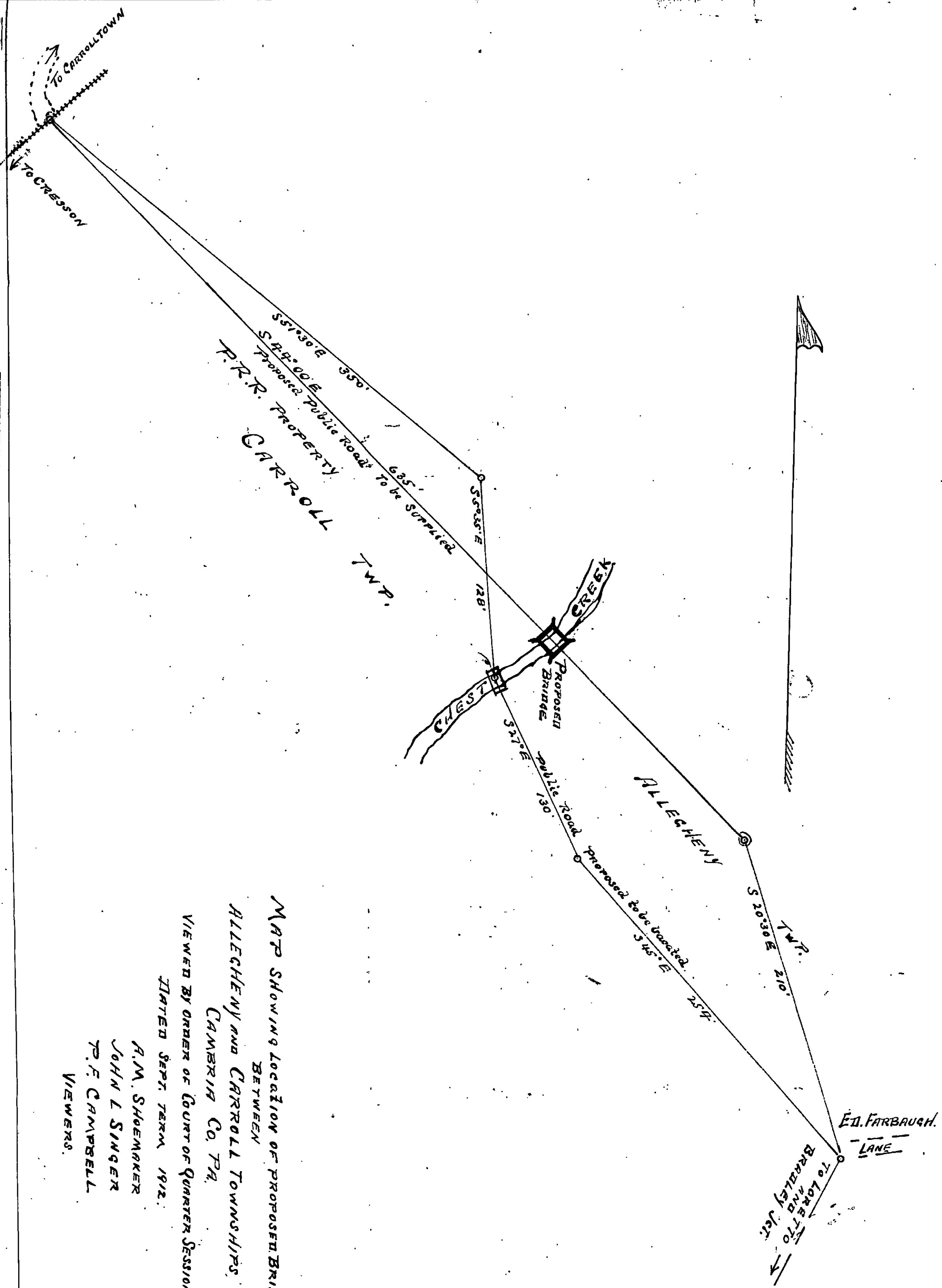
