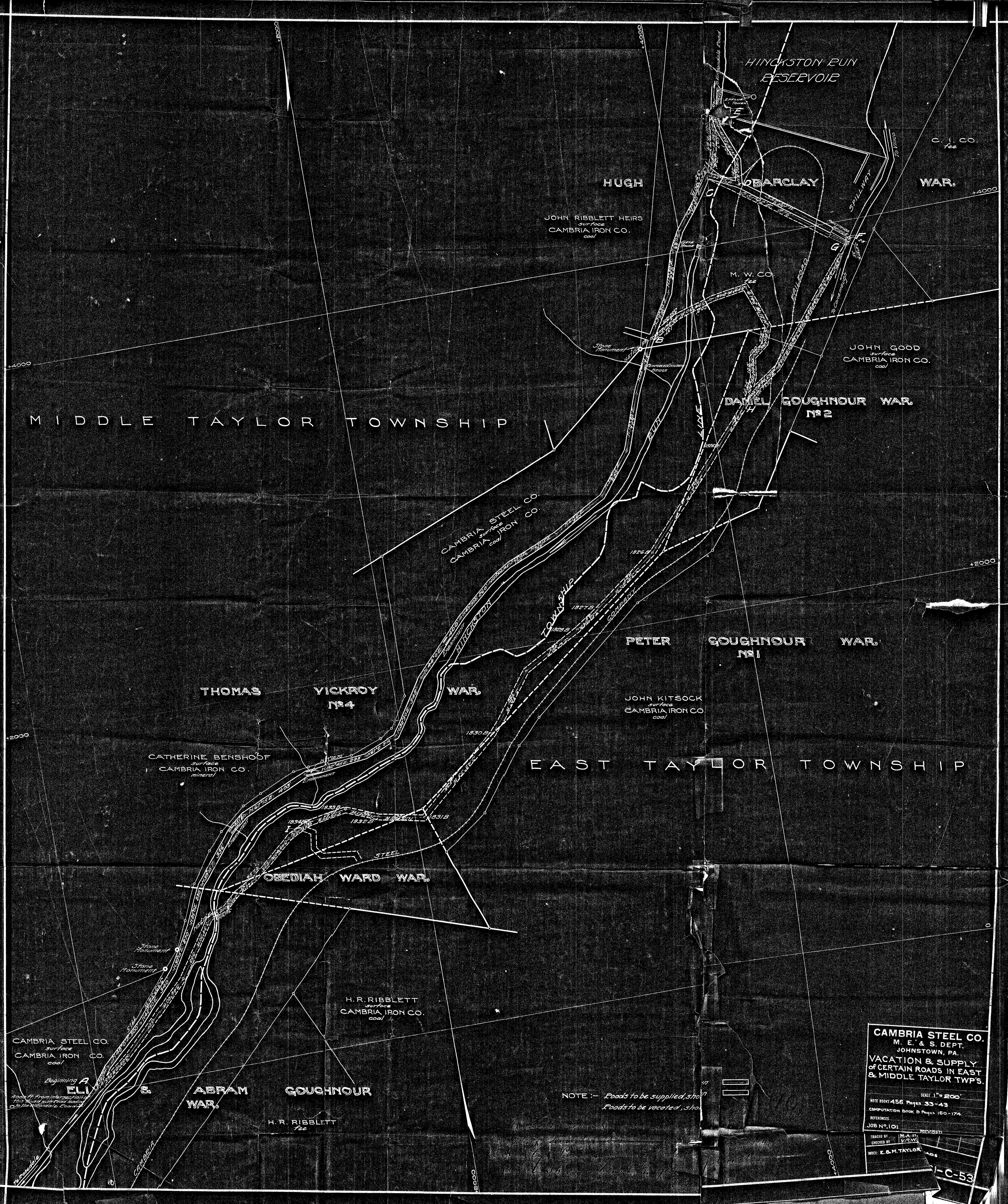

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the...20th.....day of January.....A. D. 1924 , before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Middle and East Taylor Twp. in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public.....road or highway, ~~to lead from~~ to begin at a point on a public highway, known as the Vintondale Road in Middle Taylor Township two hundred fifty-four feet from its intersection with the Hinckson Run Road, also a public highway in said Township being the nearest intersection highway, and ending at a point on said Hinckson Run Road six hundred eighty-nine feet from its junction with a highway, known as the Conemaugh Road in East Taylor Twp., being the nearest intersection highway.....

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three viewers qualified according to law to view the ground proposed for such road and if th they see occasion to lay out the same, to inquire of and vacate a public road now open, beginning at a point on said Vintondale Road eleven hundred twenty-five and seven-tenths feet distant from the nearest intersation highway, being the Hinckson Run Road aforesaid, and ending at a point on said Honckson Run Road thirtyfeet from the intersection of said Hinckson Run road and a pubic highway, known as the Conemaugh Road, leading from said Hinckson Run Road to the Ebensburg Road, both public highways. Which highway by reason of the laying out of the proposed road will become useless

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint A. M. Shoemaker.....surveyor, and..... Russell R. Yost and Fred J. Custer.....

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

Report of Viewers.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of Viewers of Cambria County appointed upon the attached Order of Court, for the purpose therein stated, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of Middle Taylor Township and East Taylor Township, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the points of beginning and ending of the piece of road proposed to be vacated and the piece of road proposed to be supplied; All of us met in accordance with the notices so given and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment according to the best of our judgment, skill and ability; We viewed the premises and are of opinion that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted and that certain piece of public road beginning at a point on the Vintondale Road 1125.7 feet from the intersection of said road with the Hinckson Run Road and running thence South 11 degrees West 64 feet, South 9 degrees 30 minutes West 150.7 feet, South 18 degrees West 104 feet, South 27 degrees West 32 feet, South 51 degrees 42 minutes East 876 feet to the place of ending, being a point on the Hinckson Run Road 30 feet from the intersection of said last named road with a public road known as the Conemaugh road leading from said Hinckson Run Road to the Ebensburg road; should be vacated and a piece of road beginning at a point on the road known as the Vintondale road, in Middle Taylor Township, 254 feet from
