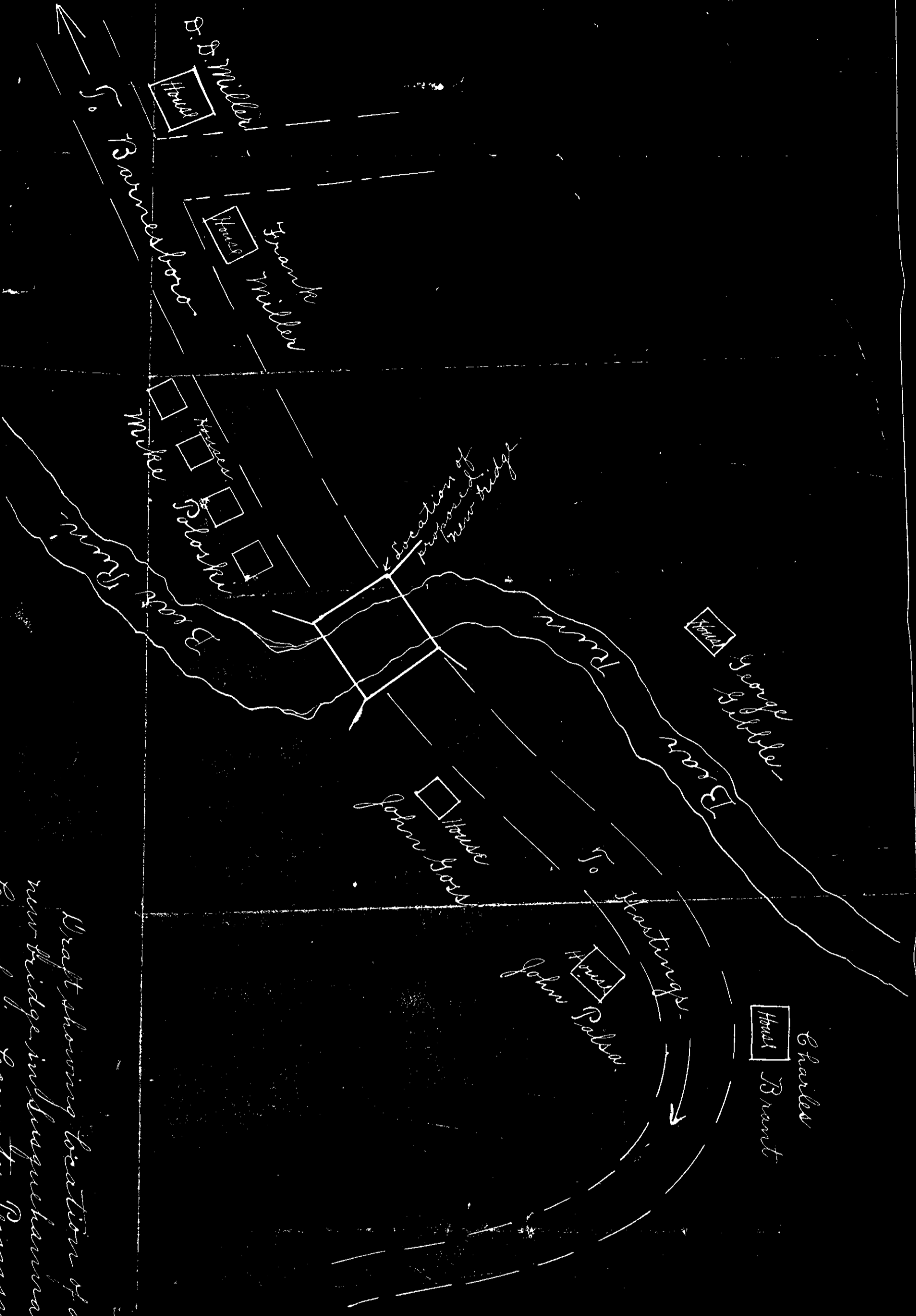

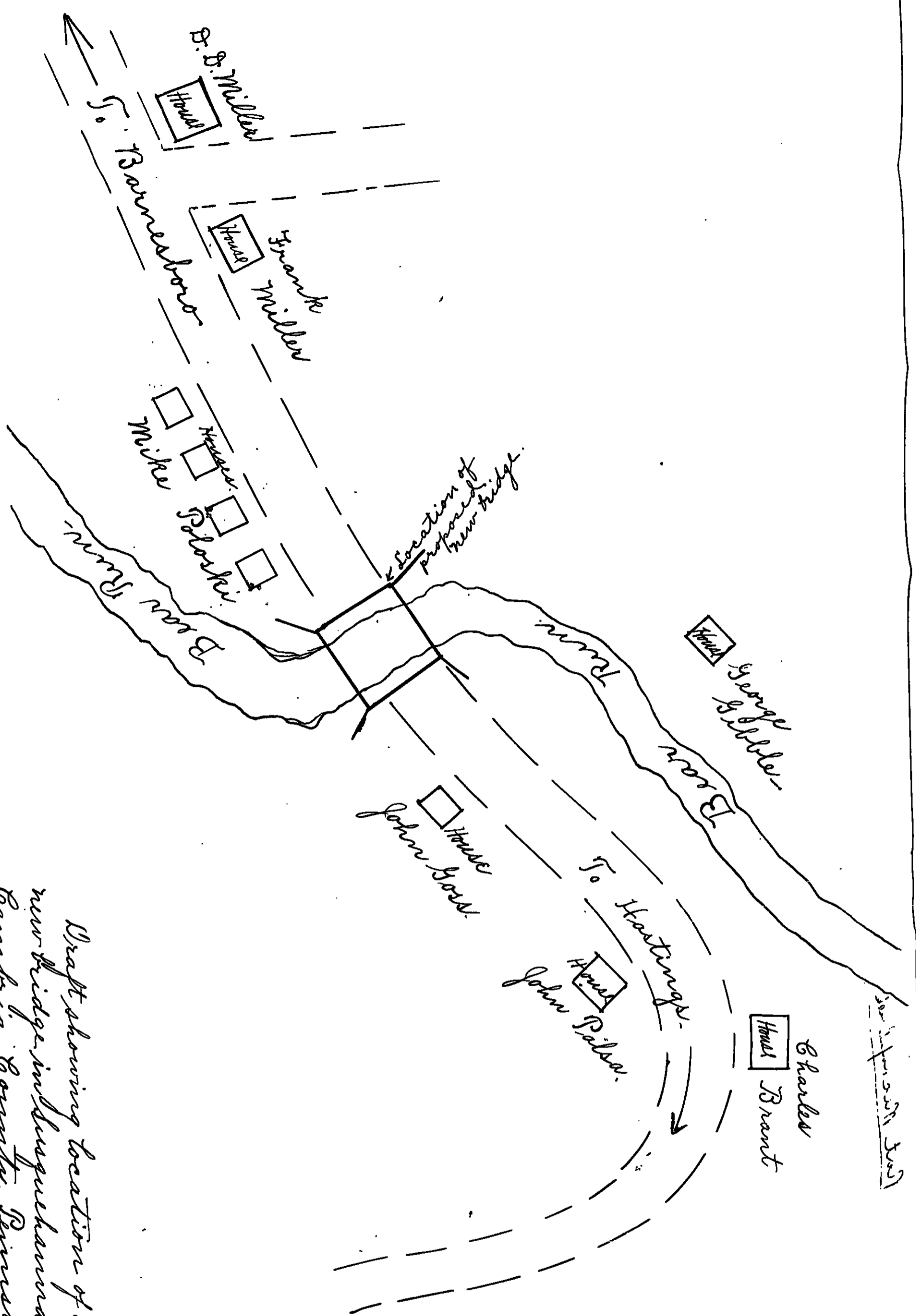

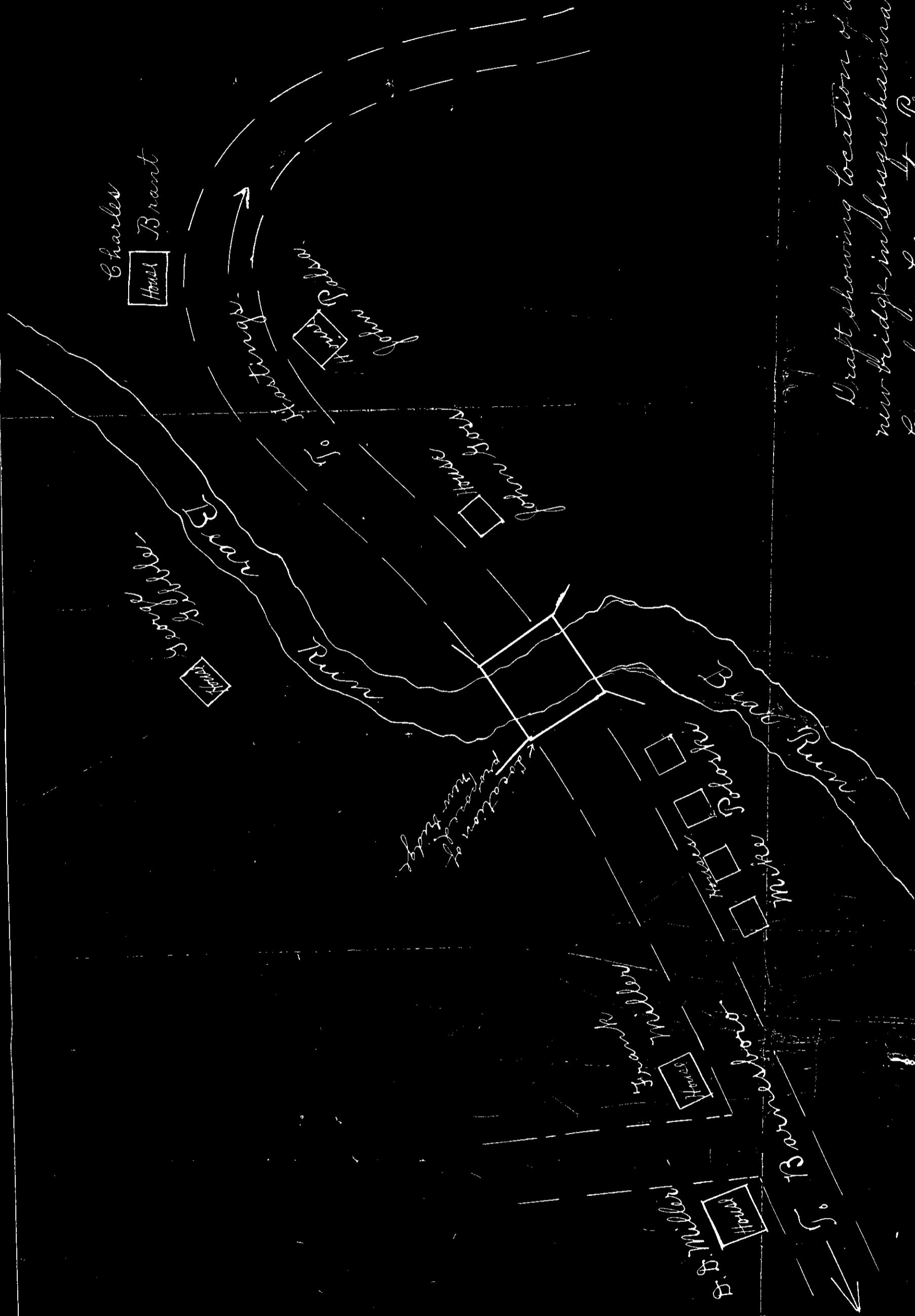

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable Marlin Bingham Stephens, President Judge
of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court upon the annexed order, to view the site where the township road leading from Barnesboro to Hastings, crosses Bear Run, in Susquehanna Township, this County to determine as to the necessity of erecting a new bridge over said Run at this point; respectfully report:

That having given due public notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of Susquehanna Township, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the site of the proposed bridge: And in accord with the notices so given, all of us met and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our ability; We viewed the site proposed and are of opinion that a new and more substantial structure over Bear Run where the township road leading from Barnesboro to Hastings crosses said run in Susquehanna Township, and that the cost of constructing a suitable and proper bridge at this point would necessitate the expenditure of more than it is reasonable the taxpayers of the said township should be required to bear and therefore we recommend that the expense of constructing a suitable bridge at this point be borne by the County of Cambria.

Further, having very carefully viewed the situation, the viewers beg leave to suggest that the new bridge constructed at this

point should, in their opinion, be eighteen feet wide, have a span of eighteen feet and be sixteen inches higher than the present old structures.
