Report of Viewers.

To the Honorable Marlin Bingham Stephens, President Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by Your Honorable Court upon the attached order, for the purposes therein set forth, respectfully report:

That having given due public notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of Susquehanna Township, by notices of which they have accepted service and which are hereto attached and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the road to be viewed; And in accordance with the notices so given, all of us met and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our ability; We viewed the premises and are of opinion that the road is necessary for a public road and that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted, and therefore we have laid out a road ; a plot or draft of which is hereto attached, made a part of this report and returned for public use; which shows the road as laid out to begin at a point on the public road leading from Plattsville to the Barnesboro and Hastings road, 3275 feet Northwardly along said road from the said Barnesboro- Hastings road and taking the following courses and distances, viz: North 59 degrees West 183 feet; North 56 $\frac{3}{4}$ degrees West 69 feet; North 75 $\frac{3}{4}$ degrees West 411 feet; North 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 142 feet; North 40 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 216 feet; North 52 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 814 feet; North 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 209 feet; North 60 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 136 feet; North 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 204 feet; South 80 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West

325 feet; South 83 degrees West 595 feet; North 89 1/2 degrees West 612 feet; North 83 1/2 degrees West 618 feet; South 74 1/4 degrees West 382 feet; South 56 degrees West 145 feet; South 36 degrees West 463 feet; South 50 degrees West 285 feet; South 56 degrees West 560 feet; South 73 3/4 degrees West 405 feet; South 41 degrees West 544 feet; South 47 1/2 degrees West 720 feet; South 52 degrees West 152 feet and South 6 degrees West 1120 feet to a point on the public road leading from Barnesboro to Hastings , on line of D. D. Miller and Frank Miller; a distance of 375 feet Easterly along said road from the road leading from the Barnesboro-Hastings road to Byrneville: Said points of beginning and ending being the points noted on the attached order: The road as laid out passes through and over property of B. A. Lantzy, Mrs. W. E. Lantzy, Casper Miller, Thomas Barnes, and Frank Byrnes. The viewers having failed to obtain releases of damages from Casper Miller and Frank Byrnes , We have assessed Casper Millers damages at ~~RM~~ Two Hundred Sixty (260.00.) Dollars and Frank Byrnes damages at Ninety \$90.00) Dollars.

D. 1903 , before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of.....Susquehanna....., in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a....public.....road or highway, to lead from a driven stake on line of land of D. D. Miller and Frank Miller, on the northerly line of the public road leading from Barnesboro to Hastings, and a distance of three hundred and seventy-five feet easterly, along said road, from the public road at the easterly limits of the Borough of Barnesboro, leading from said Barnesboro-Hastings road to Byrneville and extending thence ~~from xxxxxx~~ to a driven stake on line of land of B. viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
