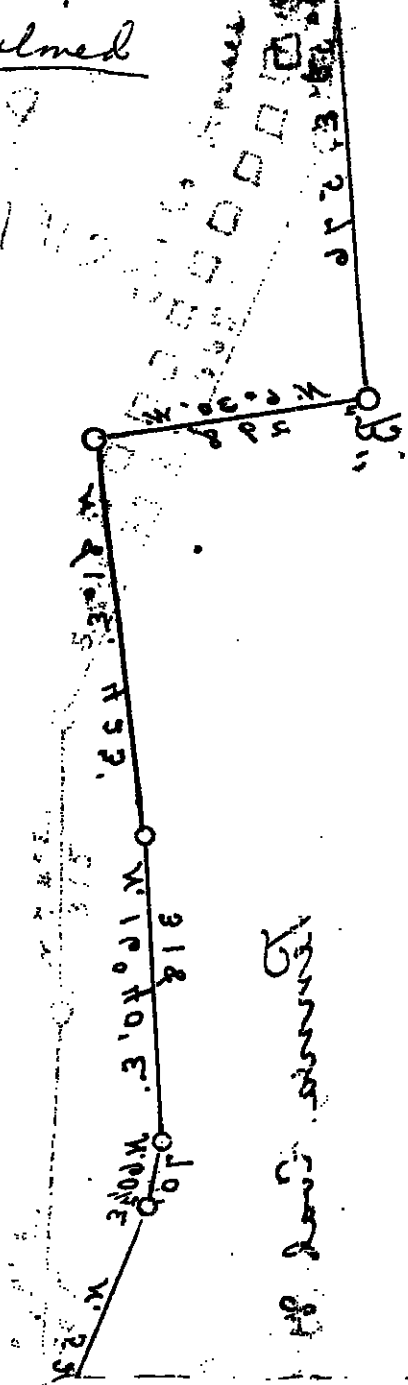

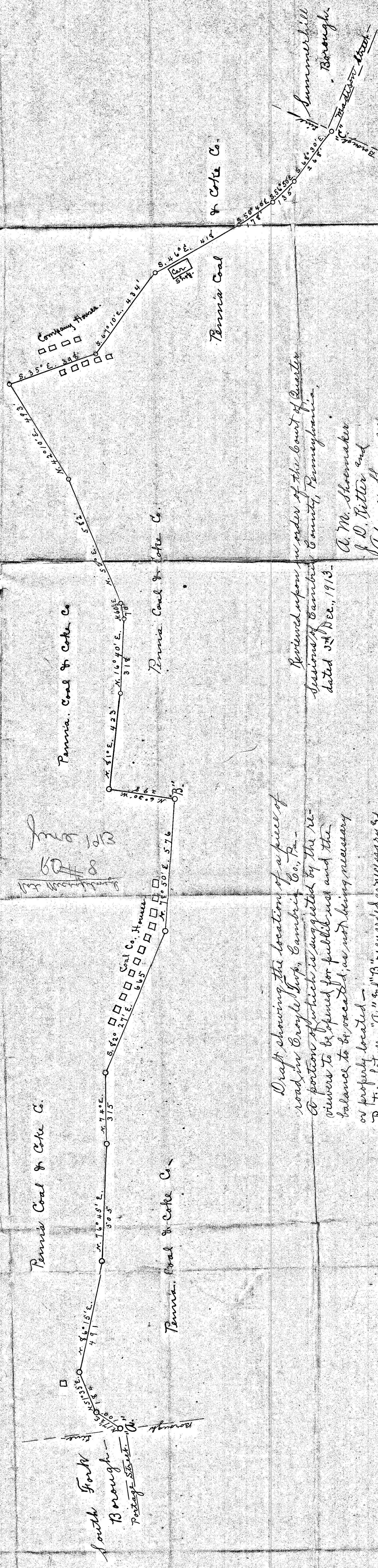

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed upon the attached order of Court, for the purposes therein stated, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of the Township of Croyle, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the road to be reviewed, and in the vicinity thereof; and having been duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment, skill and ability; All of us met in accordance with the notices so given, and having carefully viewed the premises, are of opinion that the road between the terminal points as stated in the attached order of court and as laid out by the viewers, is not necessary for a public road.

However, that portion of the road as laid out and included between points marked "A" and "B"; on the draft hereto attached, made a part of this report and returned for public use; is necessary for the benefit of the public, and should be built without further delay; but that portion of the road as laid out by the viewers and included between points, on attached draft, marked "B" and "C"; we are of the opinion is not properly located and is not necessary for a public road.

That portion of the road as laid out and which we believe to be very necessary for a public road begins at a point on the South Fork Borough line , more definitely located on the attached order of Court, as being at the intersection of the line of South Fork Borough and Portage Street in said borough, and running thence North 17 degrees 30 minutes East 100 feet, North 51 degrees 35 minutes East 184 feet, North 86 degrees 15 minutes East 491 feet, North 76 degrees 45 minutes East 505 feet, North 74 degrees East 315 feet, South 82 degrees 27 minutes East 665 feet and North 75 degrees 50 minutes East 576 feet to point marked "B" on attached draft. The location of the balance of the road which includes that portion which we are of opinion is not necessary for a public road is shown on the draft attached.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
