### REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court Of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pengsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed upon the attached order of the Court, for the purpose therein set forth, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the County Commissioners and the Supervisors of the Townships of Conemaugh and East Taylor, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the proposed new road and other public places in the vicinity thereof; And in-accord ance with the notices given all of us met at the place appointed, and having carefully gone over the ground, laid out what we considered the best obtainable and only practical route for a public road between the terminal points noted in the order of Court: All of us having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment, skill and ability: And having so viewed the premises as aforesaid; We are of opinion that a new public road between the terminal points as noted on the attached order of Court is not necessary .

The route gone over and believed to be the only practical location for a road between the terminal points noted in said order, takes the following courses and distances; as noted on the plot or draft hereto attached and made a part of this report; Beginning on the public road leading from Mineral Point to the Frankstown Road, at the point noted on said order, and running thence along a very

"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."
