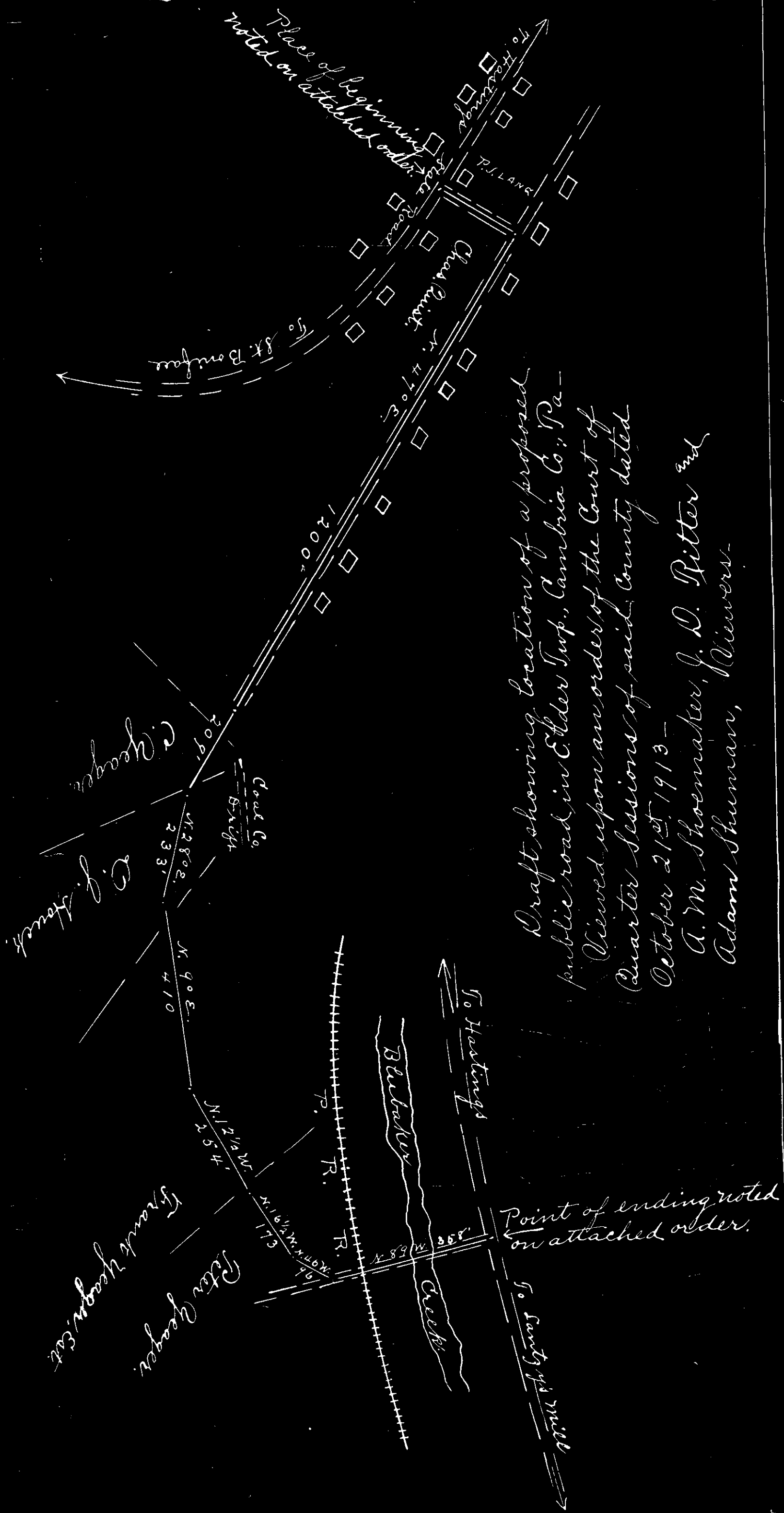



Report of Viewers.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order, for the purposes therein set forth, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County by having them accept service of an attached notice, to the Supervisors of the Township of Elder by letting them read and reading to them a copy of the attached notice, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the ends and along the route of the proposed new road; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment according to the best of our judgment, skill and ability: We viewed the premises and are of opinion that a new road between the points stated on the attached order is necessary for the convenience and accommodation of the citizens of the township of Elder, living in that vicinity, and for the traveling public generally and therefore we laid out a road between the said points along a line which we believed to be the best location for a public road, would be the most convenient and do the least injury to private property.

The road as laid out begins at a point on the public road leading from Hastings to St. Boniface, 1450 feet from where the public road leading from Hastings to St. Boniface is intersected by the State Road leading from Hastings to Lantzy's Mills and takes the following courses and distances: North forty three degrees West one hundred eighty eight feet along a private alley, thence along a road

dedicated to the public, North forty seven degrees East twelve hundred feet, then by the same course two hundred nine feet crossing the corner of property of C. Yeager, then North twenty eight degrees East two hundred thirty three feet and North nine degrees East four hundred ten feet, crossing corner of land of D. J. Houck and on to land of Frank Yeager Est., then North twelve and one half degrees West two hundred fifty four feet on to property of Peter Yeager and crossing his land North sixteen and one half degrees West one hundred seventy three feet and North forty six degrees West ninety six feet to a private road, thence along said private road North eighty nine degrees West three hundred fifty eight feet to the point of ending, near the school house, on the State Road leading from Hastings to Lantzys Mills, 1090 feet from where said road from Hastings to Lantzy's Mills is intersected by the public road leading to Platsville; being wholly in Elder Township, Cambria County,

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

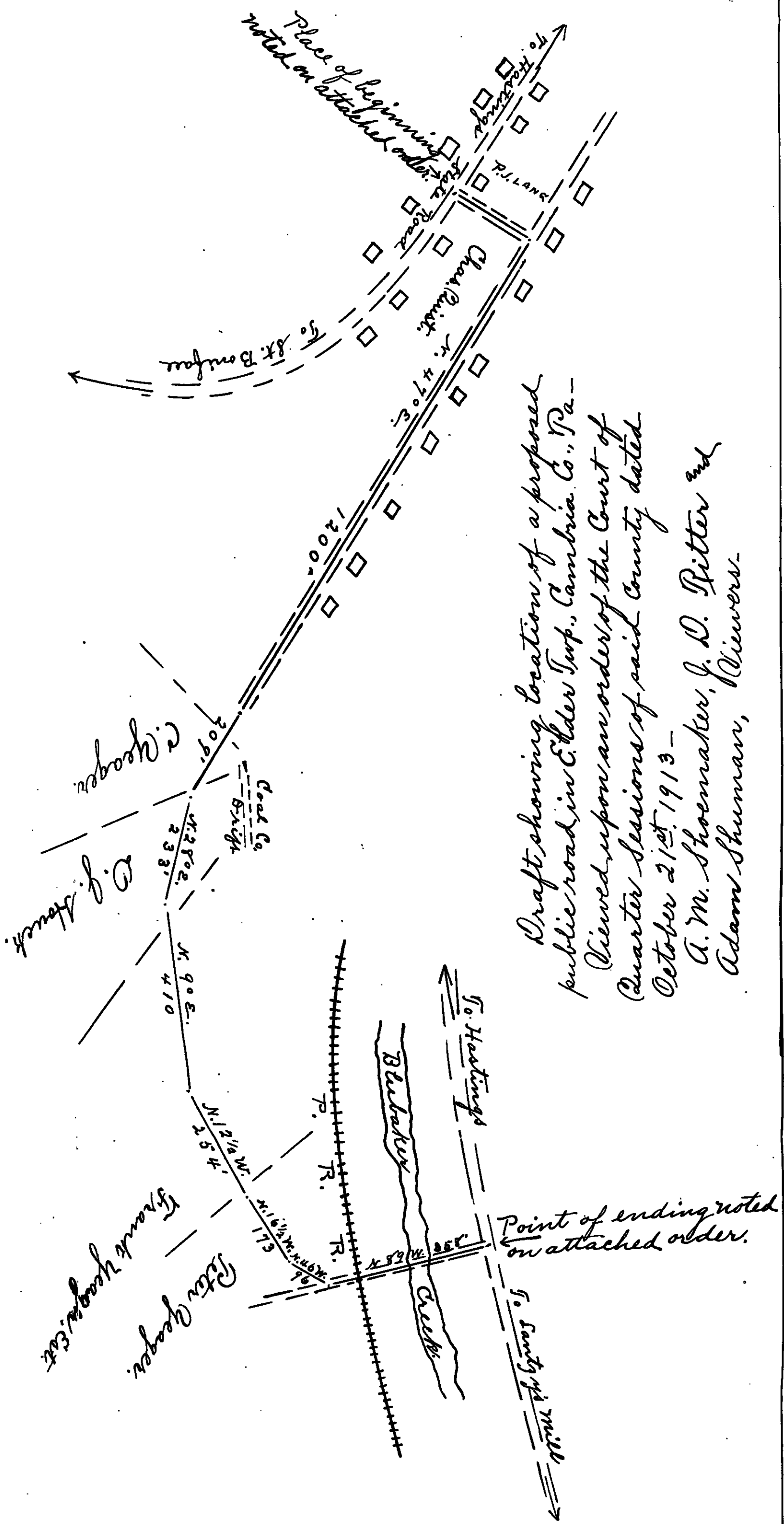
