TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS
OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA.:--

We, the undersigned, Members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court to view the site for a County bridge over Deep Hollow Run in East Taylor Township, where the public Highway leading from East Conemaugh Borough line to the Ebensburg Road crosses said hollow, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers, to the County Commissioners and the Supervisors of East Taylor Township, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the traveling public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the site of the said proposed new bridge; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; all of us met in accordance with the notices so given and having viewed the site above referred to, are of opinion that a bridge, or other structure in the nature thereof, is necessary for the safety and convenience of the traveling public at this point and further that the construction of a suitable structure at this point would entail the expenditure of more than is reasonable that the taxpayers of the Township of East Taylor should be required to bear and therefore recommend that the same be constructed at the expense of the County of Cambria.

Owing to the nature of the ground where the public road above referred to crosses the said run at this point, the Viewers are of opinion that a bridge seventy six feet long and thirty two feet high over the middle of the said run, would be required:

The Viewers beg leave to suggest that in their opinion, rather than constructing and maintaining such a bridge as would be necessary in order to cross the Run at this point, that a concrete arch or culvert not over ten feet in width and eight feet high together with proper concrete or stone retaining walls on either side, with proper filling, would not be more expensive and at the same time would be more lasting and substantial.

A plot or draft showing the location of the proposed site and a bridge such as is asked for is hereto attached and made a part of this report.
