The petition of Citizens' Cemetery Association respectfully represents:

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the attached order of the above Court to view the premises, to determine and estimate the damages that have resulted or that may seem likely to result to the property of the Citizens' Cemetery Association, situate in Southmont Borough and the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, between Grant Street and the intersection of Diamond Boulevard in Southmont Borough, by reason of the location and construction of State Highway Route 11011-Spur Section 1 by the Highway Department of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, respectively report as follows:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as Members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County as attested by the records of said Court; that due Notice was given, to the public, at least ten days prior to the holding of said View, of the time and place of meeting for Viewing the premises and the taking of Testimony by posting said Notices on the premises affected, by publication of said Notice in one issue of the Johnstown Tribune, by service of said Notice on the Commissioners of Cambria County, the Solicitor for Cambria County, the Solicitors for the Citizens' Cemetery Association and the Secretary of the Citizens' Cemetery Association, evidence of which is shown by copies of said Notices hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met in accordance with the Notice given on the 7th day of December A. D. 1943, and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises affected; that during the View the three Viewers, the Solicitors for the petitioner and several representatives and the Secretary of the Citizens' Cemetery Association were

present. After viewing the premises, we continued the View to meet in the Judges' Chambers, 505 United States National Bank Building, Franklin Street, Johnstown, Pa. at 10:00 o'clock A. M. on the 15th day of February A. D. 1944. However, on account of some of the Attorneys not being able to appear said meeting was continued to the 23rd day of February A. D. 1944; that we met in accordance with said continuance at 10:00 o'clock A. M. on the 23rd day of February A. D. 1944 and proceeded with the taking of Testimony at which time James A. Graham, Philip N. Shettig and James R. Graham, Attorneys for the petitioner, George M. Spence, Solicitor for Cambria County, H. F. Dorr, County Engineer and the Viewers were present. After hearing certain evidence, and by request of Counsel for the petitioner. and the County the meeting was continued to the 26th day of February A. D. 19坤; that in accordance with said continuance we met at the Judges! Chambers at 10:00 o'clock A. M. on the 26th day of February A. D. 1944 and proceeded with the taking of Testimony at which time a map was offered showing the property of the Citizens' Cemetery Association enclosed within the yellow lines shown thereon, State Highway Route #11011-Spur Section 1 as constructed colored in green thereon and the main Driveway of the Grandview Cemetery cut off at the Chapin Memorial Arch and rendered useless colored in red thereon. There being no objections said offer was admitted. Also the certificate of Incorporation of the Citizens! Cemetery Association and the deeds of the various tracts of land owned by the Citizens' Cemetery Association as set forth in "Petition for Decree appointing Viewers" and as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, referred to in said petition a copy of which is hereto attached was offered and admitted. Also the Act of the Legislature, #295 approved July 12, 1935, P.L. 746, establishing Legislative Route 11011-Spur Section 1 and the Act of June 23, 1931,

P.L. 920, as amended by the Act of June 1, 1933, P.L. 1412, as amended by the Act of May 21, 1937, P.L. 757, condemning said right of way was offered and admitted as set forth in copy of the "Petition for Decree appointing Viewers". Also the resolution of the County Commissioners in session on June 30, 1939 as set forth in the "Petition for Decree appointing Viewers" was offered and admitted; that H. E. Stutzman, a witness for the petitioner, was called, affirmed and testified that he had been Assistant Superintendent for the Citizens' Cemetery Association from 1913 to 1922 and Superintendent from 1922 to date. He was further qualified as an expert on Cemetery valuations, which qualification was admitted, and testified as to the value of the property of the Citizens : Cemetery Association immediately before said condemnation and improvements and as unaffected by said improvements and the value immediately after said improvements and as affected by said condemnation and improvements. After cross-examination by Attorney Spence for the County, no other witnesses were called. James A. Graham, one of the Attorneys for the petitioner informed us that said property of the Citizens! Cemetery Association was tax free: that same is free and clear of all liens, judgments and mortgages which is further confirmed by a Certificate from Graham, Yost, Meyers and Graham, Attorneys for Citizens! Cemetery Association which is hereto attached and made a part hereof. After concluding the taking of Testimony, we reviewed the evidence, test imony and exhibits and after due consideration of same we estimated and determined the damages sustained by the Citizens' Cemetery Association for the purpose of preparing a Schedule of Damages.

That Notice of the time and place of meeting for the purpose of exhibiting a Schedule of Damages was given at least ten days prior to the time of said meeting to all parties interested, by personal service of same upon the petitioner, which was accepted by George Walker Williams, Secretary, and Graham, Yost Meyers and Graham, Solicitors for the petitioner and upon the County

Commissioners which was accepted by H. F. Dorr, Chief Clerk and George M. Spence, Solicitor for the County Commissioners and by publication of said Notice in one issue of the Johnstown Tribune evidence of which is shown by copies of said Notices hereto attached and made a part hereof; that we met in accordance with the Not; ice given for the Exhibit of Schedule at the Judges! Chambers, 505 United States National Bank Building, Franklin Street, Johnstown, Pa. on the 29th day of February A. D. 1944 at 10:00 o'clock A. M. and exhibited said Schedule, a copy of which is hereto attached and made a part hereof. During the Exhibit of Schedule representatives of the Citizens' Cemetery Association and the County of Cambria and the Viewers were present. No exceptions or further Testimony were offered; that after due consideration of all Exhibits, Testimony and all other matters before us, we have assessed benefits and damages to the Citizens' Cemetery Association as follows:


