IN RE CONSENT OF COMMISSIONERS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY TO THE TAKING OVER BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ROAD IN UPPER YODER TOWNSHIP, KNOWN AS THE BENSCREEK PIKE.

Commissioners in session, Frank P. Hollern and John Thomas, Jr., present.

John Thomas, Jr., offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:
WHEREAS; the County of Cambria is responsible for the construction or maintenance of the highway known as the Bensoreak Pike, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 1575 feet north of intersection of State Highway Route No. 219 and Route 867 in Upper Yoder Township; thence from this point by way of the center line of the old Bensoreek Pike in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 810 feet, more or less, to a point at the intersection of State Highway Route No. 219 and Route No. 53, Route No. 53 being known locally as the Davidsville Road.

AND, WHEREAS, by Act approved May 28, 1948, being Act No. 588 of the 1948
Sessions of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it is provided
that where any county is responsible for the construction or maintenance of any highway,
such highway shall, if and when the County Commissioners consent thereto by proceedings,
a copy of which shall be filed in the office of the Courts of the proper County and with
the Department of Highways, be adopted by the Commonwealth as a State Highway and shall
thereafter be constructed, repaired and maintained at the expense of the Commonwealth
as State Highways are now constructed, repaired and maintained under the provisions
of existing laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved by the Commissioners of Cambria County in regular meeting assembled that the consent of the Commissioners of Cambria County be and the same is hereby given to the adoption of the County road situate in Upper Yoder Township, known locally as the Benscreek Pike, as hereinabove described, by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a State Highway.
