PETITION FOR ACCEPTANCE OF PORTIONS OF MAIN STREET EXTENDED,

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CONEMAUGH TOWNSHIP respectfully represents:

1. That upon petition of the residents and owners of lots hereto attached and made part hereof on portions of Main Street Extended, Coshun Street and Trapoli Street, not heretofore adopted by your petitioner, being dedicated streets in the said Township of Conemaugh and part of the recorded plans of Emma F. Warfel, as laid out by R. Harry Shaffer, C. E. and Fetterman Engineering Company on July 12, 1921 and July 21, 1942, respectively, recorded in Plat Book, Vol. 2, Page 125 and Vol.            Page            respectively, your petitioner has accepted the said portions of Main Street Extended, Coshun Street and Trapoli Street, subject to the consent of your Honorable Court as more fully appears by Resolution of your petitioner, hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "Exhibit A."

ORDER OF THE COURT

NOW, the 21 day of *Feb*, 1944, the within petition having been read and considered, the court hereby gives its consent that the following portions of Main Street Extended, Coshun Street and Trapoli Street and described in Resolution hereto attached as "Exhibit A" being dedicated streets on the plans of lots of Emma F. Warfel, said plans being laid out on July 12, 1921 and July 21, 1942, respectively and having been recorded in the Recorder of Deeds office in and for Cambria County in Plat Book, Vol. 2, Page 125 and Vol. 3, Page 180 respectively in Conemaugh Township, be accepted as public highways and/or streets, said streets being described as follows:

1. MAIN STREET EXTENDED, Beginning on the Frankstown Road known as State Highway Route No. 53 to the Northern line of Trapoli Street.
2. CUSHUN STREET from Main Street Extended Eastwardly past the Lincoln School, and Westwardly to Hawkins Avenue.
3. TRAPOLI STREET, from Main Street Extended to Hawkins Avenue.

And further it is ordered and directed that the said portions of Main Street Extended, Coshun Street and Trapoli Street forthwith be and become a part of the highway system of the Township of Conemaugh, Cambria County, and be it still further ordered and directed that this proceeding be recorded in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

"EXHIBIT A"

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners and citizens of the Township of Conemaugh have petitioned us, the Conemaugh Township Supervisors to adopt certain portions of streets and/or public highways in the said Township as public roads, said streets and/or highways having been laid out as streets on the plan of lots laid out by Emma F. Warfel in Conemaugh Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania on July 12, 1921 by R. Harry Shaffer, C. E., which plan is recorded in Plat Book, Vol. 2, Page 125 and another plan of the said lots as laid out by Emma F. Warfel on July 21, 1942 by the Fetterman Engineering Company is likewise recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Plat Book, Vol. 3, Page 180; and

WHEREAS, said petitioners and citizens of the Township of Conemaugh, residing on said portions of streets and/or highways, which have heretofore never been accepted by the township supervisors, suffer great inconvenience by reason that the same have never been accepted as public streets and/or highways by the Supervisors of Conemaugh Township; and

WHEREAS, it is now the intention and the desire of the Supervisors of the said Township of Conemaugh to accept the hereinafter described portions of streets in pursuance to the Act of Assembly of 1935 P. L. 1299, Section 1147; 53 P. S. Section 19093-1141 in such case made and provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the following portions of Main Street Extended, Coshun Street and Trapoli Street be accepted by the Supervisors of Conemaugh Township as township streets and/or highways:

1. MAIN STREET EXTENDED, Beginning on the Frankstown Road known as State Highway Route No. 53 to the Northern line of Trapoli Street.
2. COSHUN STREET from Main Street Extended Eastwardly past the Lincoln School, and Westwardly to Hawkins Avenue.
3. TRAPOLI STREET, from Main Street Extended to Hawkins Avenue.
