

Rat Michaelined ROFF9 June 1938 Upper Yoder, Tup, Layout of a Rublic Nighter

# REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the termini of the said proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached, and by service of such notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township through their Solicitor, service of said notice by the County Commissioners and the Solicitor for the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township being hereto attached; that one of the Viewers, S. E. Dickey, met in accordance with the notice given on the 9th day of September A. D. 1938 at 2:30 o'clock P. M. (Eastern Standard Time); that several residents of the Township were present, but on account of Messrs. Baumgardner and McCann, the other two Viewers, being unable to be present, the view was continued to the 15th day of September A. D. 1938 at 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Eastern Standard Time); that in accordance with said continuance, we met on the 15th day of September A. D. 1938 at 2:00 o'clock P. M. (Eastern Standard Time) and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed said proposed new road follows a dedicated new road; that highway known as Antonia Street, forty (40) feet in width, a portion of which is now opened as a private road; that all the abutting property on either side of said Antonia Street is laid \ out in building lots, nine (9) of which are already occupied with residents; that during the view the Viewers named herein and representatives of the Board of Supervisors and

residents of the Township of Upper Yoder were present and heard; that no objections were made against the proposed road by the Supervisors or any resident of the Township of Upper Yoder; that the proposed road is situate in the Beechwood section, strictly a residental section of Upper Yoder Township, which is rapidly developing with a large number of houses now completed and under construction; that after viewing the premises and the route of the proposed road, we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for the proposed new road, therefore, we proceeded to lay out same as follows: Beginning at a point in Keppler Drive N.64°06'E. 342.57 feet along the center line of Keppler Drive from its intersection with Lilly Street a public highway, being a State Road leading from Ferndale to Menoher Highway; thence by the center line of Antonia Street, a dedicated highway forty (40) feet in width, S.41°39'E. 948.11 feet to the center line of Miller Court; being the boundary line between the said Township of Upper Yoder and the Borough of Southmont, the place of ending, said Miller Court being a public highway in the Borough of Southmont; said ending being N.50°03'E. a distance of 317.47 feet measured along the center line of Miller Court from its intersection with Lilly Street, a public highway, being a State Road leading from Ferndale to Menoher Highway, all of which is shown colored green on the blue print attached here to and made a part hereof.

That the route of the proposed road as hereinbefore mentioned follows a dedicated highway and is through a plan of building lots, nine (9) of which are occupied with residents.

That after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that the road as prayed for by the petitioners and laid out by us is necessary and convenient

and not burdensome to the taxpayers of Upper Yoder Township, therefore, we recommend that the prayer of the Petitioners be granted.

Inasmuch as the right of way required for said road is already dedicated as a highway and no additional width will be required from the adjoining property owners, we assess no benefits and no damages to any of the abutting property owners.

"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fall to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."
