That said properties consist of dairy and produce farms. That we are greatly in need of a Public Road to supply said properties and for the purpose of making a shorter connecting link between the Fender Lane or Dalton Run Road and the Menoher Highway. That said proposed road is necessary and convenient for the traveling public.

body to procede with the necessary legislation required for laying out, excepting, opening, improving and maintaining said proposed road as a public Highway in said Township of Upper Yoder, beginning at a point in the Fender Lane or Dalton Run Road and extending in a Westerly and Northerly direction and ending at a point in the Menoher Highway, the exact location of said place of beginning from the nearest intersecting Public Highway, namely, the Coon Ridge Road is 2100 feet measured in a Southerly direction along the center line of the Fender Lane or Dalton Run Road from said Coon Ridge Road. REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the termini of the said proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached, and by service of such notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, and Solicitor for the Supervisor of Upper Yoder Township, service of said notice by the County Commissioners and the Solicitor for Upper Yoder Township being hereto attached; that copies of said notice were also served upon the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township; that we met in accordance with the notice given on the 20th. day of July A. D. 1940 at 10:000'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and Viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road: that S. E. Dickey, Wm. J. McGrain and L. E. Kaylor, Viewers were all present: that the supervisors of Upper Yoder Township were not present or represented by council and have not filed any objections with the Viewers against said proposed new road; that the property owners abutting on the route of the said proposed new road were. present during the view and were heard, all of whom stated they were in favor of the road and willing to contribute all land necessary for the required right of way and have signed a release of damages; that the proposed new road passes through an area of highly culivated farm land; that four of the abutting property owners on the proposed

road, namely, William V. Shaffer, James Thomas, Luther Layman and Wilbur J. Hofecker have no access to a public highway except by use of a private lane through other property; that after Viewing the premises and the route of the proposed road we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for same, therefor, we proceeded to layout same as follows: Beginning at a point in Fender Lane or Dalton Kun Road at the intersection of the private lane leading to the buildings on the Blair Hunt farm, the exact location of said place of beginning is at a distance of 2100 feet measured along the center line of the Fender Lane or Dalton Run Road in a Southerly direction from the intersection of another public road known as Coon Ridge Road; thence through land of Blair Hunt S.68°52'W., 514 feet to the point of a curve to the left, having a radius of 786.04 feet; thence by said curve in a Westerly direction an arc distance of 198.92 feet to the point of a tangant; thence by same S.54°22'W., 30 feet to the point of a curve to the right, having a radius of 150 feet; thence by said curve in a North Westerly direction an arc distance of 257.70 feet to the point of a tangant; thence by said tangant which line is partly on Blair Hunt and William V. Shaffer's land, N.27°12'W., 873 feet to a point of a curve to the right, having a radius of 423.60 feet; thence by said curve in a Northerly direction through land of William V. Shaffer an arc distance of 233:87 feet to the point of a tangant; thence by said tangant through land of William V. Shaffer and Luther Layman N. 4°26'E., 1142 feet to the point of a curve to the left, having a radius of 1466.38 feet; thence continuing by said curve in a Northerly direction and through land of Luther Layman and Wilbur J. Hofecker an arc distance of 397.55 feet to the point of a tangant; thence by said tangant and through land of Wilbur J. Hofecker and Henry Hofecker N.11°06'W., 1703.00 feet to a point in the center line of the Menoher Highway the place of ending. The exact location of said place of ending is at a distance of 1450 feet measured along the center line of the Menoher Highway in a Westerly direction from the intersection of another public highway known as the Fender Lane

or Dalton Run Road: The total length of said proposed new road is 5350.04 feet, all of which is colored green on blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof. We recommend that the width of said proposed road shall be fourty (40) feet.

That after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that the road as prayed for by the Petitioners and laid out by us is necessary and convenient and will not be burdensome to the taxpayers of Upper Yoder Township, therefore, we recommend that the prayer of the Petitioners be granted.

We are also informed by the supervisors of Upper Yoder
Township that all of the abutting property owners have signed a release of damages in the petition for said proposed new highway which
was filed with the Court, however, we assess no benefit and no damages
to any of the abutting property owners.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to engdeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agree-sble to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefily the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding live degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."


