TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:--

The petition of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following facts:

1. That at a regular meeting of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, held on the twenty-fifth day of June, A. D. 1943, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, a certain section or piece of road, or street, located in the Woodvale Heights Section of East Taylor Township.

2. That the section or piece of road or street, which is to be taken over by the Township of East Taylor, is fully described in the resolution, of the Board of Road Supervisors, which is entered in the minute book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit #1." A map of the proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit #2."

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over of the said road or street, as a township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18th, A. D. 1935, P. L. 1299, in order that such road or street shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of East Taylor.

R E S O L U T I O N

On motion of CLYDE HERALD, seconded by CHARLES COLBERT,
and duly passed, it was

RESOLVED, that the Board of Road Supervisors of East
Taylor Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania,
accept as a public highway that section of road or street, located
in the Woodvale Heights Section of the said Township of East Taylor:

Piece #1- BEGINNING at the intersection of Harrison Avenue and
Webster Street, on the Plan of Woodvale Heights, (at
the end of present township road); thence, South 47°
4' West along Webster Street, a distance of approxi-
mately three hundred (300) feet to Van Buren Avenue;
thence, South 62° 56' East along the line of Van Buren
Avenue, a distance of approximately nine hundred (900)
feet to Fickus Street, on the said Plan of Woodvale
Heights. The said Webster Street and Van Buren Street
being properly designated on the Plan of Woodvale Heights.

Piece #2- BEGINNING at the intersection of Calhoun Street and Fillmore
Avenue, on the Plan of Woodvale Heights; thence, South
62° 56' East along the line of Fillmore Avenue, a dis-
tance of approximately seven hundred (700) feet to line
of land formerly of William Thompson; the said Fillmore
Avenue being properly designated on the Plan of Woodvale
Heights.

THE SAID PLAN of Woodvale Heights having been laid out
by S. G. Fetterman, C. E., and recorded on the day
of , A. D. 19 , in the office of the Recorder
of Deeds in and for Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in
Plat Book Volume , Page ; the said road or street
which is hereby accepted by the said Township of East
Taylor, as a public highway, having a width of feet.

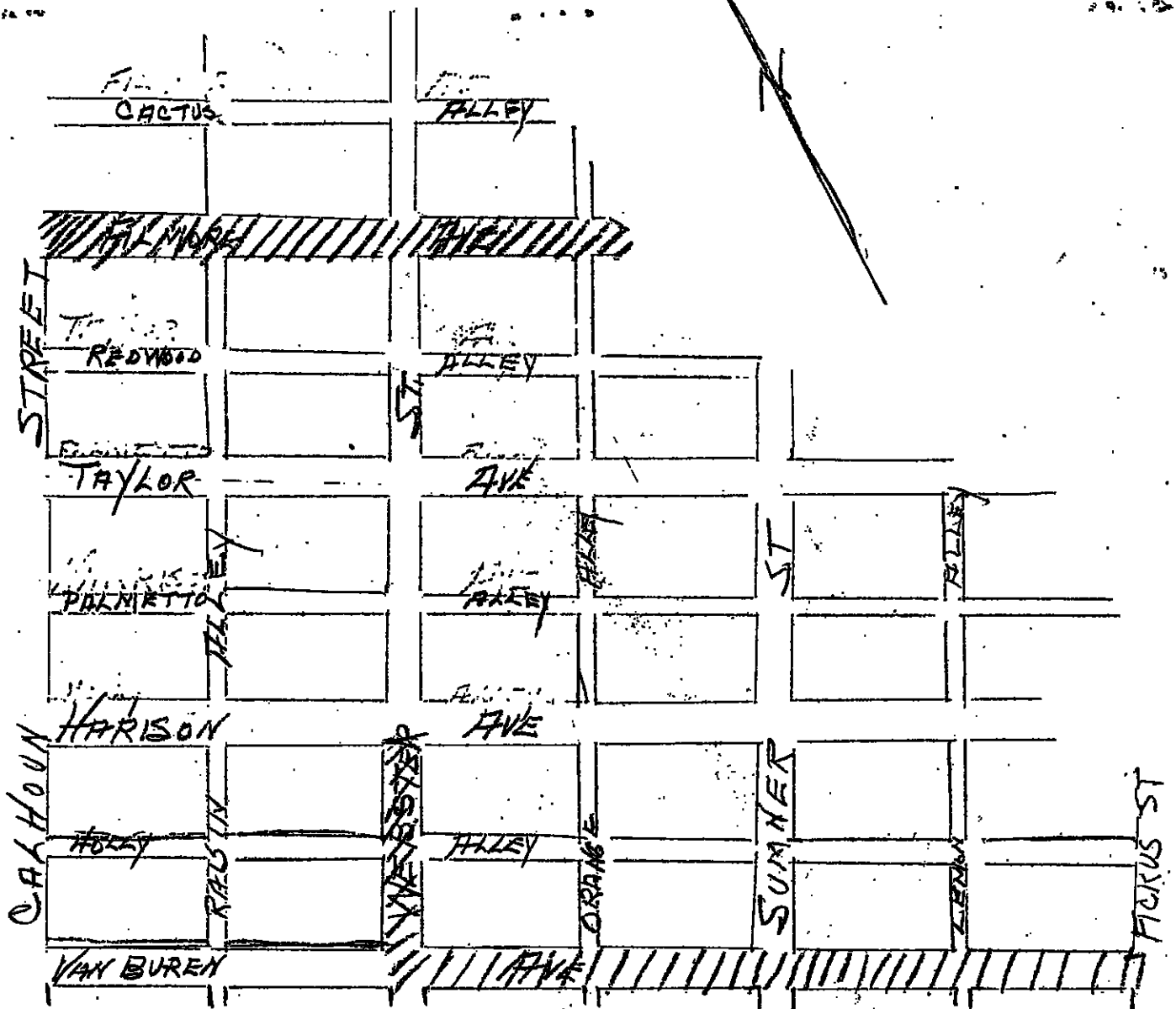
