### REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter  
Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court and directed to view the premises to determine as to the necessity for a public highway as prayed for by the Petitioners, beginning on the easterly side of public highway Route No. 219, on public highway leading from the City of Johnstown to Mundys Corner; said land thence extends North 67 degrees 35 minutes East, a distance of 1457.2 feet on the Northerly side, and approximately 1475.5 feet on the Southerly side; said street is thirty (30) feet in width throughout its entire length, and it extends from the point where it intersects with the Easterly line of State Highway Route No. 219 hereinabove mentioned, to land now owned by Ralph Hagerich and wife.

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers to the Commissioners of said County, to the three Supervisors of Jackson Township and to the public by printed hand bills posted at and in the immediate vicinity of the premises to be viewed for the proposed public highway, as is required by the Act of the General Assembly.

All of us met upon the premises in Jackson Township, Cambria County, Penna., on Saturday October 26, 1946, at 2 o'clock p. m. to perform the duties of our appointment, together with the said three Supervisors, most of the owners of the lots facing said proposed street and others who assured us they were authorized to represent petitioners who could not arrange to be present.

The said proposed street, named Griffith Avenue, nearly bisects the tract of land that was owned by Harry H. Griffith; the said tract extending from State Highway, Route 219, to land now owned by Ralph Hagerich and wife, and is bounded on the north by lands owned by Kenneth Griffith and Ralph Hagerich and on the south by Dwight Griffith, Ernest Grumbling and Paul Susko.

The Plan of Lots is on record in Plat Book Vol. 3, Page 193.

The said street or Griffith Avenue is 1466.4 feet in length.

We are informed that all lots are sold save five (5) Nos. 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27 which are retained by the said Harry H. Griffith, shown on map attached hereto. Fine looking houses are built on lots Nos. 15, 16, 18 and 19 and two are under construction on lots 7 and 8.

The Petitioners would, unquestionably, be inconvenienced by making the said Griffith Avenue a public highway.

Furthermore its the consensus that the section involved will become a considerably built up section within a comparatively short period of time. And so far as the Township is concerned it will benefit directly by reason of the fact that after the homes are built the assessment will be changed from vacant land to houses and lots, and it should increase the revenue of the Township by a considerable amount.

The Viewers, therefore, in compliance with their duties have estimated and determined the benefits, agreeing there is occasion for a public road; with the understanding, however, that Jackson Township and Cambria County be released from all claims for damages that may arise from opening of said road.

We have notified the parties interested that this report will be filed with the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, on or before the first Monday of December, 1946, as required.

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

1. The undersigned petitioners are residents and tax payers of the Township of Jackson, in the County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania.

2. The undersigned are owners of lots abutting on Griffith Avenue, which said street is shown upon a recorded plan of lots of Harry H. Griffith, which plan of lots is of record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, in and for Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Vol. 3, at page 193.

3. Your petitioners and other tax payers and inhabitants of Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, suffer a great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway at the location of Griffith Avenue, as shown upon the plan of lots hereinabove mentioned, and your petitioners believe and therefore aver that a public road or highway is necessary for public travel.

4. A description of the road desired to be laid out is as follows:  
BEGINNING on the Easterly side of public highway Route No. 219, on public highway leading from the city of Johnstown to Mundys Corner; said land thence extends North 67 degrees 35 minutes East, a distance of 1457.2 feet on the Northerly side, and approximately 1475.5 feet on the Southerly side; said street is thirty (30) feet inwidth throughout its entire length, and it extends from the point where it intersects with the Easterly line of State highway Route No. 219 hereinabove mentioned, to land now owned by Ralph Hagerich and wife.

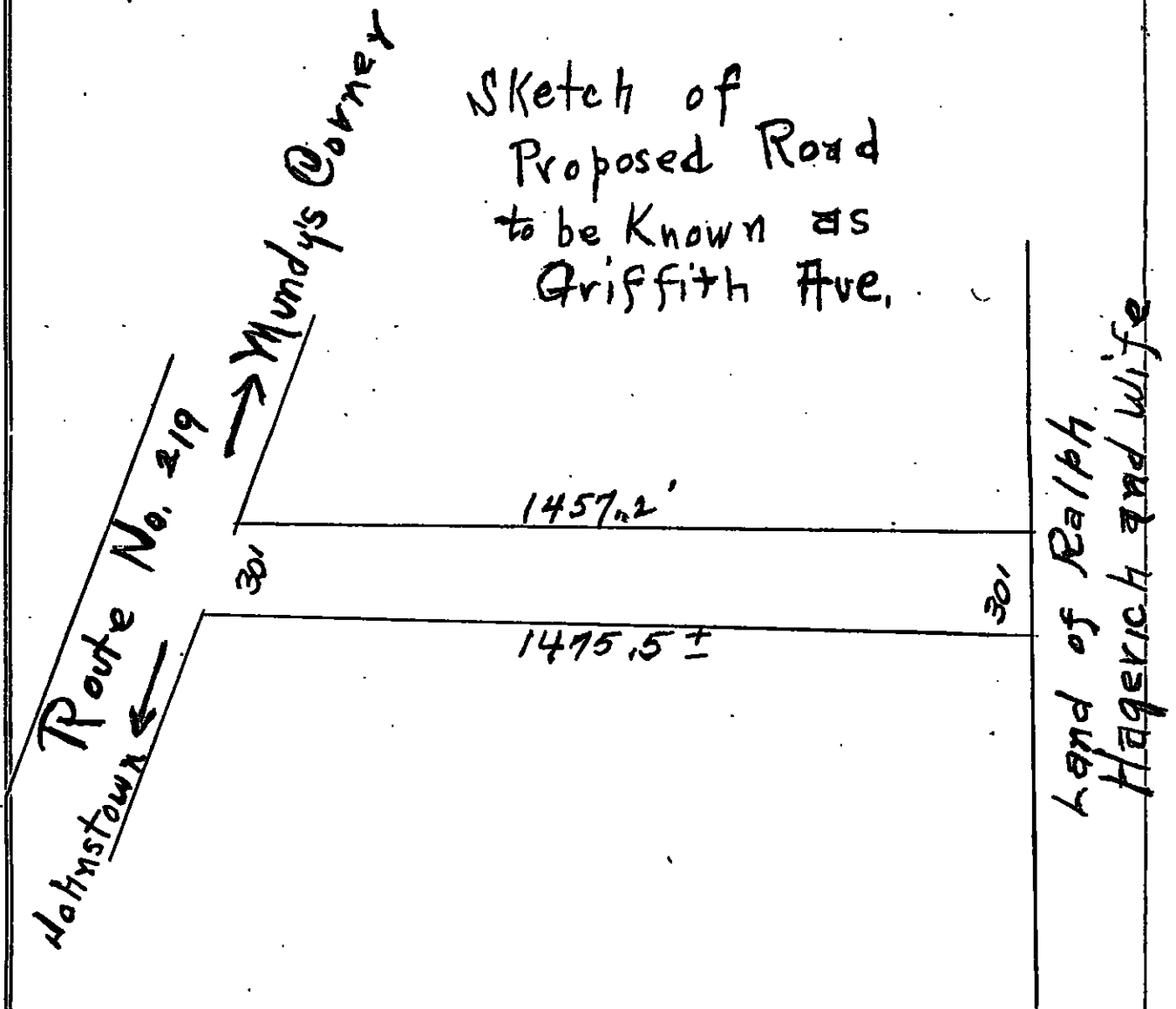
