TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE-NAMED COURT: --

The petition of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following facts:--;

1. That, at a regular meeting of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, held on the 27th day of September, A.D., 1946, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a Township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, that certain section of road or street located on the Bole Plan of Lots as laid for I. C. Bole, July 30, 1908, by Fetterman Engineering Company, in the Township of East Taylor.

2. That, the section or piece of road or street which is to be taken over by the Township of East Taylor, is fully described in the resolution of the Board of Road Supervisors, which is entered in the minute book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit # 1." A map of the proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit # 2."

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over of the said road or street, as a township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18th, A. D., 1935, P. L. 1299, in order that such road or street shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of East Taylor.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Road Supervisors of East Taylor Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, accept as a public road or highway that certain section of road or street located on the Bole Plan of Lots as laid for I. C. Bole, on July 30, 1908, by Fetterman Engineering Company, in the Township of East Taylor:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the public highway leading from State Highway Route No. 219 to Woodvale Heights and Calhoun Street, as described on the Bole Plan of Lots laid out for I. C. Bole, July 30, 1908, by Fetterman Engineering Company, thence, along the line of Calhoun Street on the Plan of Lots in an easterly direction, a distance of 1800 feet, more or less, to the intersection of Calhoun Street and Bole Street, extended; the said certain road or street which is hereby accepted by the said Township of East Taylor as a public highway, having a width of forty (40) feet.

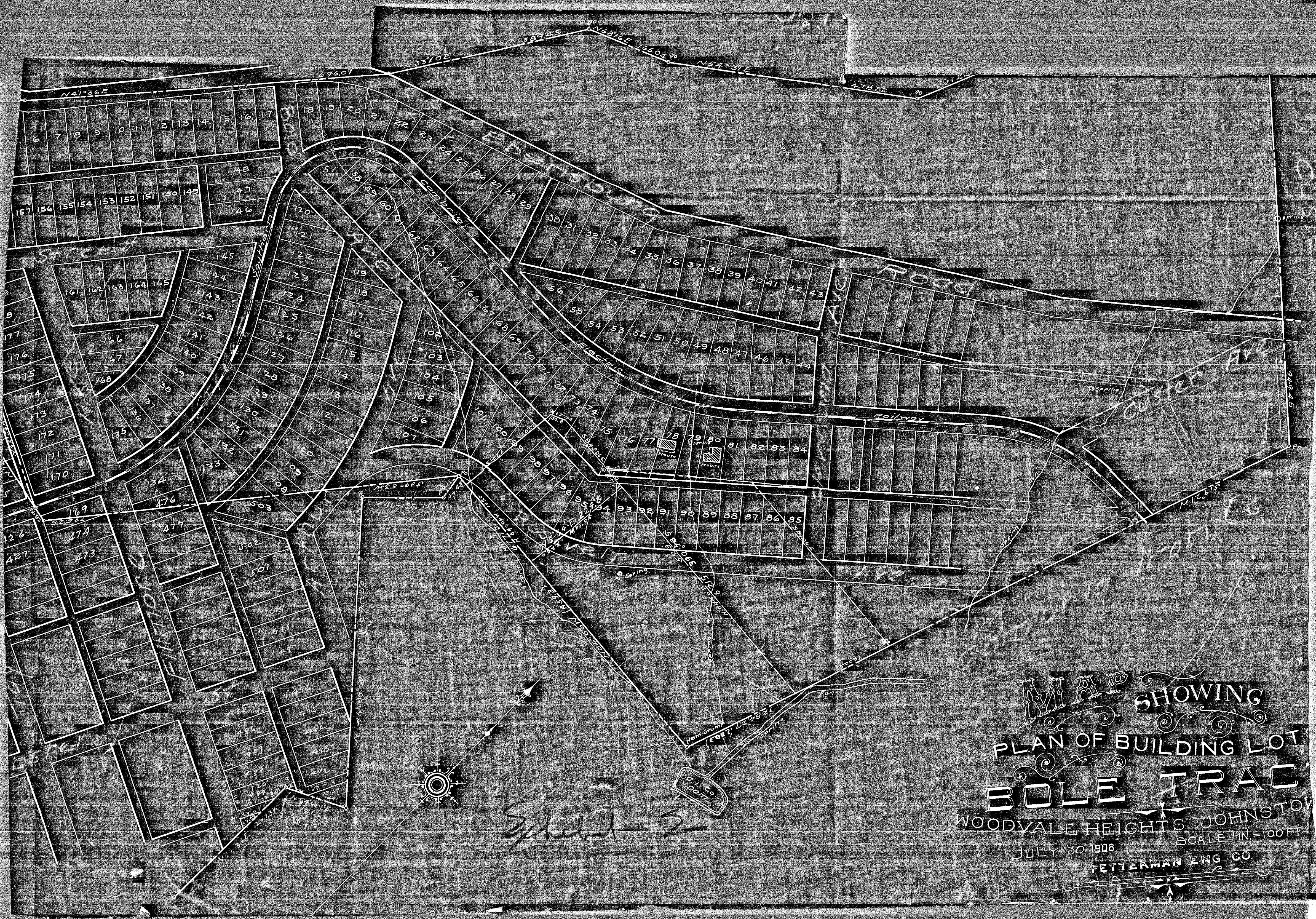
