REPORT OF VIEWERS

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the above named Court respectfully make the following Report.

~~That we~~
~~The were~~ were duly qualified by law to serve as Viewers as is shown by the records of said Court and that the order of Court called for the laying out of certain streets and avenues in the Village of Revloc, Township of Cambria, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania and that the petitioners who were the owners of homes and lots thereon abutting to wit: Wood Avenue, Penn Avenue, Fourth Street and parts of Highland Avenue, Cambria Avenue and Sixth Strtts labor under great inconvenience for want of the above named avenues and streets. That due notice of the time and place of the meeting of the Viewers was made according to law by the posting of ten notices at conspicuous points along the streets and avenues above designated at least ten days before the time of the view which said date was fixed for Tuesday, September 5, 1944 at 10 o'clock meeting at Wood Street; and by notice upon Evans and Evans, Esqs. Counsel for the petitioners acceptance of which said notice is hereby attached and by handing said Counsel of said notice and by the acceptance of service of said notice to View by A. W. Evans, Secretary to the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cambria a copy of which is hereto attached and made a part of this report and a copy being handed him and by the acceptance of service on H. F. Dorr, Chief Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners of Cambria County, Pa., said acceptance being hereto attached and made a part of this report as well as a copy of same having been handed to him. A notice posted on the premises is also attached hereto and made a part of this Report.

In accordance with said notice the viewers L. E. Kaylor, S. H. Jencks and Mahlon Baumgardner named in said order of Court viewed the premises on Tuesday September 5 1944 at 10 o'clock in the morning. There were present at said view

William Novick and the three Supervisors of the Township of Cambria. We viewed the streets and avenues proposed to be opened and laid out for public use. Upon inquiry the Viewers were informed that there^{was} about 179 houses situate along said streets and avenues and some lots not yet sold, there being approximately 263 families in said houses and that the total population of said village is about 1350 persons. The petition praying for the opening and laying out of said streets and avenues was voluminously signed by said owners and purchasers of houses and lots. The village of Revloc was laid out about the year 1917. The members of the board of Viewers having viewed the streets and avenues set out in the petition are unanimous in opinion that the said prayer of the petitioners should be granted and therefore recommend the laying out and hereby do lay out said streets and avenues as prayed for. Since the plan of the Village of Revloc includes all of the streets and avenues and said plan is of record in the proper office of Cambria County, Penna., courses and distances are not enumerated because same are shown on said plan. WE THEREFORE lay out for public use the following Highland Avenue, Cambria Avenue, Wood Avenue, Harding Avenue not including parts shown on the accompanying and hereto attached map in color. Said portions of the hereinabove named avenues have already been laid out as public highways. We also lay out Eighth Street, Seventh Street, 6th Street, 5th Street not included in the colored part on of the blue print hereto attached for similar reason of said streets have at a prior date been laid out as public streets. A copy of the Monroe Coal Mining Company Plan of Revloc, Cambria County, Pa., laid out on Surface Acquired from John Kirschner et ux by deed dated August 13, 1913 and recorded in Deed Book Volume 247 and page 394 and recorded in the office for the Recording of Plans. Since the inhabitants and the petitioners having been using said streets and avenues for many years as private streets and avenues we believe that avenues and streets as above laid ^{out} ~~laid~~ by said Viewers is only fair and equitable to the owners and purchasers of homes in said Village of Revloc.





NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass: and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of the undersigned citizens of the Township of Cambria respectfully represents:

That they are owners and purchasers of houses and lots in the Village of Revloc, in said Township, abutting on the several Streets and Avenues, as laid out by the Monroe Coal Mining Company, and shown on map thereof, duly recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Plat Book No. 3, Page 181.

That they labor under a great inconvenience by reason of the fact that the said Streets and Avenues, or parts of the same, have not been taken over by the Township of Cambria. The said Streets and Avenues are as follows:- Wood Avenue, Harding Avenue, Penn Avenue, Fourth Street, Seventh Street, and the parts of Highland Avenue, Cambria Avenue and Sixth Street which have not heretofore been taken over by said Township; said Streets and Avenues are parallel to or at right angles with Fifth Street, which has heretofore been taken over as a township highway and which, extended in a Northerly direction, intersects with the Benjamin Franklin Highway, known as United States Route 422, at a point about two and one-half miles Westward from the Borough of Ebensburg.

Your petitioners, therefore, pray the Court to inquire of said Streets and Avenues and open the same as public highways, and for that purpose to appoint Viewers, according to law, to view the same and inquire of the premises and make Return of their proceedings, according to the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided.
