TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA: 1

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the said Township of Upper Yoder, County aforesaid, respectfully represents:

That your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway in the said Township of Upper Yoder, to begin at a point in Goucher Street, a public highway, and extending over and across Magdalene Street to the southerly side of Susquehama Street; thence extending along and over Susquehama Street in a northerly direction to the Westmont Borough line, all of which is shown in green on map as laid out by S. E. Dickey & Company, Engineers, which map is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT A".

The exact distance from the point of beginning of the proposed public road from an intersecting public road, to wit: Luzerne Street, as shown on the aforesaid map, is 869 feet; and the exact distance from the point of ending of the proposed public road from an intersecting public road, to wit: Menoher Highway, as shown on the aforesaid map, is 1600 feet.

The beginning of said proposed road is in a public highway, as stated above, but the ending of said proposed road, that is the other of the termini of the said proposed road is at a point other than in a public highway or place of public resort; but the said proposed road is necessary for public travel.

A copy of the written notice to the Supervisors of said Upper Yoder Township of the intended presentation of this application, with the acceptance of service thereon, is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT B".

A release of damages whereby the owners of property abutting the aforesaid proposed road, releasing the said Township of Upper Yoder from any damages they have sustained, or may seem likely to sustain by reason of the said accepting, opening, grading, draining, improving and maintaining of said proposed highway is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT C".

### REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the attached order of the above Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the termini of said proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached and by service of said notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, Curt Barnhart, Secretary of the Board of Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, and Frank P. Barnhart, Solicitor for the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, evidence of which is shown by copies of said notice hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met in accordance with the notice given on the 16th day of March, 1945, at 10 o'clock A. M., and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road. All three Viewers and one interested citizen were present; that said proposed new road is now a dedicated highway, Magdalene Street being 50 feet in width and Susquehanna Street being 60 feet in width as shown on the John K. Miller Plan of Lots and colored in green on the blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof; that one of the termini named in the petition and in this report is at a point other than in a public highway or place of public resort, the other terminus is in a public highway; namely, Goucher Street. We find, however, that said proposed road is necessary for public travel and for the use of property owners abutting thereon. The description of said proposed road is as:

Beginning at a point in Goucher Street, the exact location of the place of beginning from the nearest intersecting public highway now Luzerne Street Extension is at a distance of 869 feet measured along the center line of Goucher Street in a northwesterly direction from said Luzerne Street Extension. exact location of the place of ending is along Magdalene Street, S. 58° 18' W., 376 feet to the intersection of Susquehanna Street; then ce along Susquehanna Street, N. 31° 42' W., 393.35 feet to the Westmont Borough Line.

Taking into consideration all of the matters before us, we are of the opinion that said road as prayed for by the petitioners and laid out by us is necessary and convenient for the several houses erected thereon and those hereinafter to be erected and will not be burdemsome to the taxpayers of Upper Yoder Township, therefore we recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted; however we assess no benefits and no damages to any of the abutting owners.

NOTE. 'It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
