TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT: --

The petition of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following facts:

1. That, at a regular meeting of this Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, held on the *27th* day of *April*, A. D. 1945, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, a certain section or piece of road, or street, located in the River View Section of East Taylor Township.

2. That the section or piece of road, or street, which is to be taken over by the Township of East Taylor, is fully described in the resolution of the Board of Road Supervisors, which is entered in the minute book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit #1". A map of the proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit #2".

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over of the said road or street, as a said township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18th, A. D. 1935, P. L. 1299, in order that such road or street shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of East Taylor.

RESOLUTION

On motion of Hiram Ribblett, seconded by

Clyde Herald, and duly passed, it was

RESOLVED, that the Board of Road Supervisors of East Taylor Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, accept as a public highway that section of road or street located in the River View Section of the said Township of East Taylor:

BEGINNING at the intersection of Samuel Street and Henry Street, on the Plan of River View, said Samuel Street now being a public road in the Township of East Taylor; thence, in a Northerly direction along the line of Henry Street a distance of approximately Six hundred sixty (660) feet to the intersection of Daniel Street, on said Plan of River View; thence, in a Westerly direction along the line of said Daniel Street, a distance of approximately Three hundred (300) feet to the intersection of the Township Road leading to Echo, said Henry Street and Daniel Street being properly dedicated on the Plan of River View laid out for John A. Angus, by the Fetterman Engineering Co., on May 23rd, 1911, said Plan of River View being recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County, Pennsylvania in Plat Book Volume Page.

The said road or street, which is hereby accepted by the said Township of East Taylor as a public highway, having a width of Forty (40) feet.
