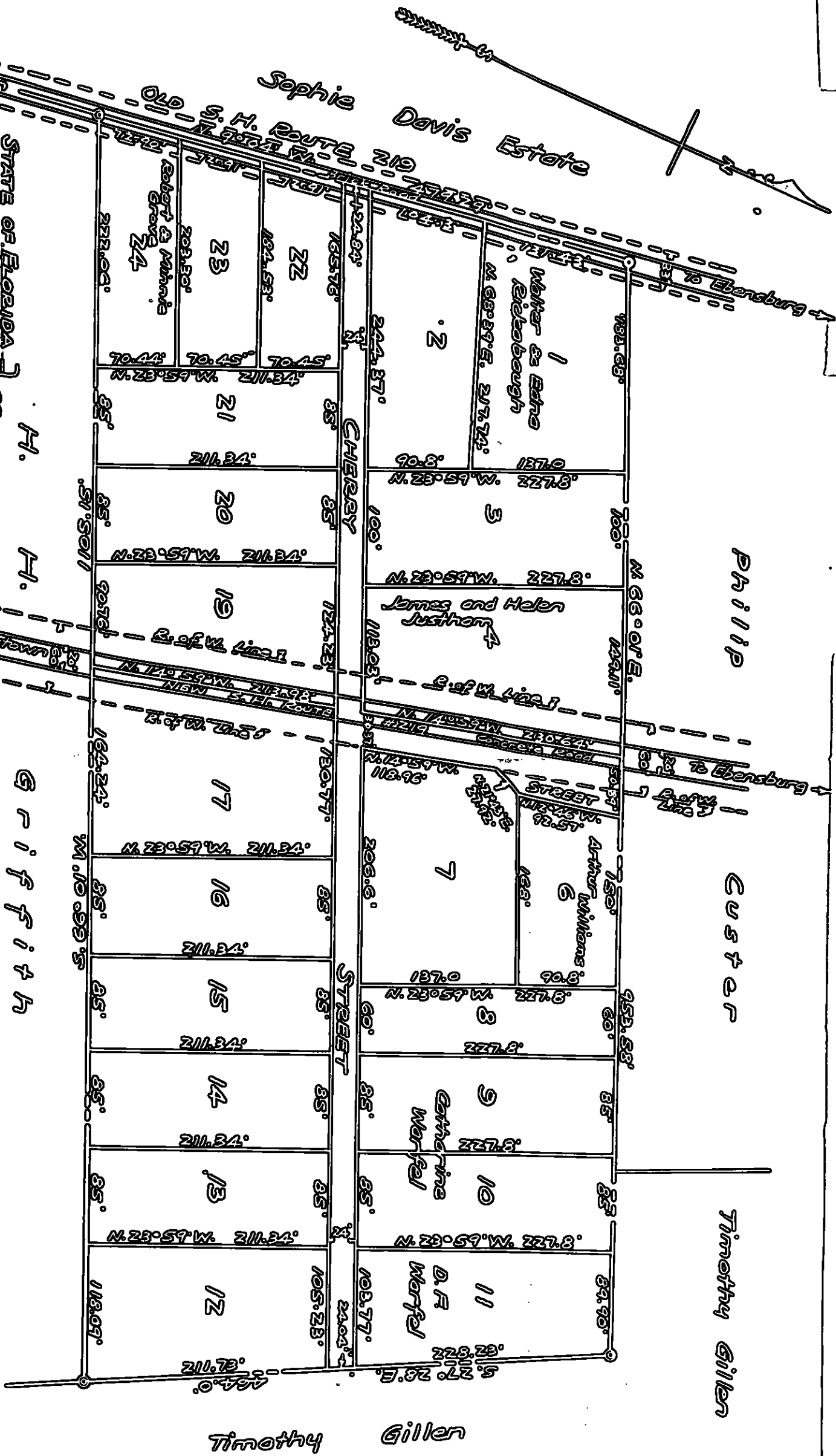

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

1. The undersigned petitioners are residents and tax payers of the Township of Jackson, in the County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania.

2. The undersigned are owners of lots abutting on Cherry Street, which said street is shown upon a recorded plan of lots of Mrs. J. W. Helsel, which plan of lots is of record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, in and for Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Vol. 3, at page 144.

3. Your petitioners and other tax payers and inhabitants of Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, suffer a great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway at the location of Cherry Street, as shown upon the plan of lots hereinabove mentioned, and your petitioners believe and therefore aver that a public road or highway is necessary for public travel.
