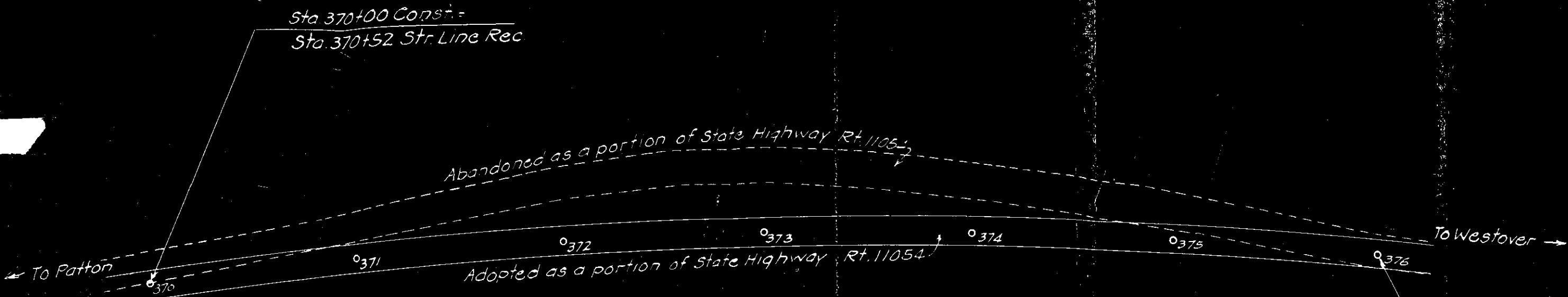

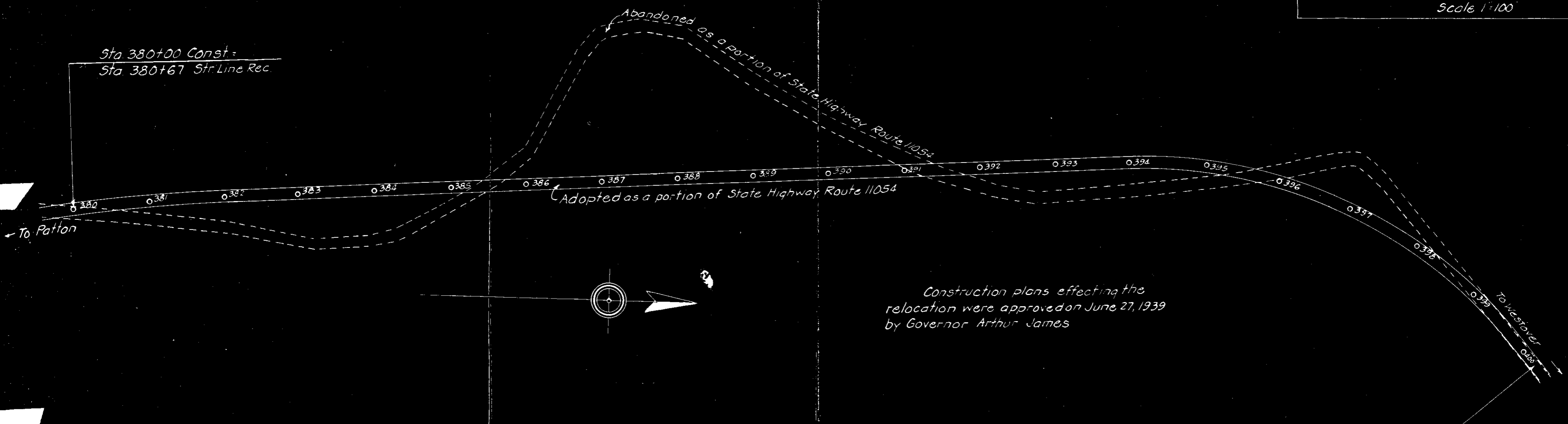

IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

No. _____ SESSIONS, 1941.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court.

The petition of the undersigned residents of the Township of Chest, in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

1. That the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in improving and reconstructing State Highway Route No. 11054, Section 1, (formerly a public highway leading from St. Lawrence in Cambria County to Westover in Clearfield County), has relocated the said Highway from a point at Station 380+67 to a point at Station 403+11, within the boundary of said Chest Township, Cambria County, a distance of approximately 2244 feet or 0.43 of a mile, also from a point at Station 370+52 to a point at Station 376+65, a distance of approximately 613 feet or 0.12 of a mile, more fully described and shown on the attached blue prints or drawings.

2. That on account of these changes of location the portions of the road originally maintained as a part of the State Highway system between the Stations above referred to were abandoned as a part of the system by the said Highway Department and revert as a public highway to the jurisdiction of the officials who maintained the same prior to its adoption as part of the State Highway system.

3. That the said road before the same was taken over by the State Highway Department was a Township road, lying within the boundary of said Township of Chest in said County.

4. That by reason of the change of location as aforesaid the portions of road originally maintained between the Stations above referred to were, as already stated, abandoned by the State Highway Department as part of the system and the said portions above described thereupon reverted as a public highway to the Township of Chest and under

the supervision of the Supervisors of said Township.

5. That the Supervisors of the Township of Chest have jurisdiction over said portions of said Highway abandoned as aforesaid and are required to maintain and keep the same in safe condition for public travel.

6. That the said portions of said Highway as aforesaid have become useless, inconvenient and burdensome by reason of the reconstruction of the said State Highway aforesaid and the relocation of the same and are no longer necessary for public use and travel, and unless the same are abandoned and vacated an useless and unnecessary burden will be placed upon the said Township of Chest in said County.

7. That the maintenance of said portions of said highway sought by this proceeding to be vacated will be burdensome to the taxpayers of the said Township of Chest, and unless maintained will become dangerous as a public thoroughfare.

8. That the point of beginning and ending of the said portions of the said Highway to be vacated are as herein already set forth and as fully shown on the blue prints or drawings which are hereto attached and made part of this petition.

WHEREFORE your petitioners respectfully pray this Honorable Court that the portions of said highway may be vacated, agreeably to the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided, and they further pray that a Rule may be granted upon the Commissioners of Cambria County pursuant to Rule No. 301-1/2 to appear and show cause, if any they have, why viewers should not be appointed for the vacation of said portions of said highway; and they will ever pray, etc.



We, The undersigned Viewers, appointed by the above named Court, to view the location and report on the advisability of vacating certain sections of State Highway , Route No. 110-54 Section I (formerly a public highway, leading from St. Lawrence, in Cambria County to the village of Westover in Clearfield County, respectfully report;

That we have given proper notice to the public by Printed Notices, posted in conspicuous places in the immediate location of the sections of the said highway to be vacated and to the County Commissioners and to the Supervisors of Chest Township of the time and place of our meeting, as per copies of the posted notices which are made a part of this report.

That at the time and place specified we met in company with Anthony Neibauer and A. J. Leiden, Supervisors of Chest Township and walked over the sections which have been relocated by the Highway Department.

Between Stations 380-67 and 403-II, a distance of 2244 feet which has been relocated by removal of a curve in the roadway.
Also between Stations 370-52 and Station 376-65, a distance of 613 feet the same straightening process has relocated the curve on the former roadway . We found that these relocated sections form a potential hazard from which the taxpayers should be relieved.

In compliance with the desires of the Supervisors, representing the Taxpayers and the petitioners the viewers were unanimous in their decision to vacate the former parts of the said highway, as prayed for by the petitioners and decree that these sections of State Highway, No. 110-54 be and are hereby Vacated, THIS ninth day of May, 1941.



OTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
