




At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 10 th day of Nov. A. D. 1941, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of White, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience ~~for want~~ ^{vacating} of a public road or highway, to lead from

The peticular portion of said public road herein requested to be vacated
begins at Station No. 101+82 and continues in a northerly direction a distance
of approximately 693 feet to Station No. 108+75, this certain peice of public
road as described above has become useless, inconvenient, and burdensome to
the tax payers of said Township by the reason of the relocation and recons-
truction of State Highway Route #11053, Section 1. leading from Glendale to
St. Augustine in said County, Township and State/

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

We, the viewers appointed by the above named Court to view the location and report on the advisability of vacating a section of vacated highway on the road leading from Glendale to St. Augustine, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

The particular section to be vacated begins at Station 101-82 and continues in a northerly direction to Station 108-75, a distance of 693 feet, Respectfully report as follows:-

That we have given proper notice to the public, by printed notices posted on the route of the relocated portions of the highway, to the supervisors of White Township and to the Commissioners of Cambria County, of the time and place of our meeting.

That at the time and place advertised we met and inspected the particular section to be vacated and found the plea of the petitioners well founded and justified, in as much as there is no need for it or justification for the township authorities to be any longer responsible for it.

Changes and alterations by the Highway Department have removed curves in the original roadway and effected removal of curves and a shortening of the distance.
