#### REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the termini of the said proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached, and by service of such notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, the Solicitor for the Petitioners and Solicitor for the Supervisors being hereto attached; that we met in accordance with the notice given, on the 28th day of December A.D. 1949, at 10:30 o'clock A.M. (Eastern Standard Time) and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road; no property owners and no Supervisors of the Township appeared, and we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for the proposed new road; that the grades are acceptable and the alignment is good, all according to attached blueprint. Beginning at a point in Robinson Avenue, which point is 112.95 feet from the southerly side of Hershberger Road, which is South 24 degrees 33 minutes West. a distance of 112.95 feet from the southerly line of Hershberger Road; thence in a straight line along Ogle Street, South 48 degrees 57 minutes East 1,200 feet to the center line of Penn Street. Said proposed road being 1,200iffeet in length as is shown on the blueprint attached hereto colored in green and made a part hereof.

In view of the absence of any interested parties at the site of the View, a hearing was called in the offices of Gray & Claflin, Consulting Civil Engineers, 606 Swank Building, on Friday, December 30, and at this hearing Mr. Curt Barnhart, Secretary of the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township was present and he favored the acceptance of this road as a township road.

That after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that the road as prayed for by the petitioners and viewed by us is necessary and convenient and will not create an undo hardship on the Supervisors, therefore we recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustanted, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforessid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
