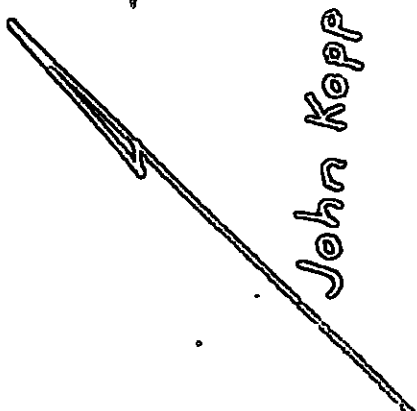

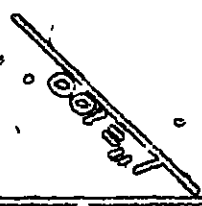

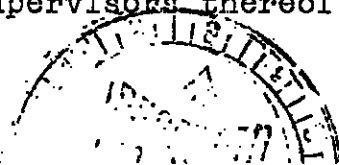

To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:

The petition of Joe Bergamaschi, Howard Lewis
and Herman E. Krug, Supervisors of Dean Township, Cambria
County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represent:

That on the _____ day of May, 1939, the then
Supervisors of Dean Township adopted a resolution, a copy of
which is hereto attached and made a part of this petition,
accepting as a Public Road of Dean Township the road therein
described, which road had been opened and dedicated to public
use as a road and used by the public for upwards of twenty-one
years prior to the adoption of said resolution and, which road has
a width of thirty-three (33) feet.

That said road was accepted, without the approval of your
honorable Court, on the theory that a road, such as the one in
question, which had been used and occupied by the traveling
public for upwards of twenty-one years, had become a public Road
by prescription, and that such a road was a public highway as
effectually as if it had been laid out under a Road View, and they
were so advised.

That, since that time, your petitioners have been advised
that the acceptance of said road should have the approval of the
Court.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that the Court may
approve the acceptance of said road by the Supervisors of Dean
Township nunc pro tunc; and they will ever pray, etc.

RESOLUTION

Whereas the owners of the land have opened and dedicated to public use a road in Dean Township Cambria County, Pennsylvania, leading from the State Highway route 507 on land of the Dean Township School District, occupied by what is known as the Richland School, a distance of 972 feet and of a width of 33 feet, to the Methodist church property and cemetery in said Township more particularly described on a plan or plat made by John L. Elder a registered engineer on May 3, 1939.

And whereas, said road has been dedicated to public use for upwards of 21 years.

And whereas, the supervisors of Dean Township are desirous of improving said road, which the public has long considered a public thoroughfare and used as such.
