



In the matter of the approval of acceptance of Road.

To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:

The petition of Joe Bergamaschi, Harvard Lewis
and Herman E. Krug Supervisors of Dean Township, Cambria
County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

That on the _____ day of May, 1939, the then Supervisors of Dean Township adopted a resolution, a copy of which is hereto attached and made a part of this petition, accepting as a Public Road of Dean Township the road therein described, which road had been dedicated to the public as a public road by the owners of the land over which said road had been laid out upwards of twenty-one years prior to the adoption of said Resolution, and had been used as public road by the public during that period, said road being known on the Plan of Dysart as Mc Millan Street, and having a width of thirty-five (35) feet.

That said road was accepted by said Supervisors, without the approval of the Court, on the theory that a road, such as the one described in the resolution, having been dedicated and used as aforesaid, became a public Highway as effectually as of it had been laid out under a regular Road View, and they were so advised.

That, since that time, your petitioners have been advised that the acceptance of said road should have the approval of the Court.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that the Court may approve the acceptance of said road by the Supervisors of Dean Township nunc pro tunc; and they will ever pray, etc.

RESOLUTION

Whereas on the plan of the Village of Dysart, located in Dean Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, there appears a street or roadway, known as McMillan Street, being a street connecting Railroad Street with State Highway Route 234, and being in length 611 feet, and of a width of 35 feet,

And whereas said street was dedicated to the public as a public thoroughfare for upwards of 21 years by the owners of the plan of lots on which said McMillan Street and for upwards of 21 years as a public road with the knowledge of the owners of the land covered by said road or street, and

Whereas the Supervisors are desirous of improving said street and accepting same as public road of said township,

Now therefore be it resolved by Lewis Hale, John L. Hughes, and Herman E. Krug, supervisors of Dean Township, Cambria County Pennsylvania that the road above referred to be accepted as a public road of Dean Township.
