To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respect-fully report;

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the termini of the said proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached, and by service of said notice upon the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township and the Solicitor of Upper Yoder Township, evidence of which is shown by copies of said notice hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met in accordance with the notice given on the lith day of October A. D. 1942 at 9:30 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road; that during the view, all of the owners of property " abutting on said proposed new road and the three Viewers were present. Objections to the opening and improving of the said proposed road were made by John Ober and Frank Hite whose properties also abut on Sell Street, an improved Highway. Also Frank A. McCallum, whose property abuts on Ruth Street, an improved Highway. After viewing the premises and hearing all. of those who were present at the View, we met at the office of S. E. Dickey & Co., 809 Johnstown Trust Bldg., Johnstown, Pa., where two of the Supervisors, namely, Curt Barnhart and D. H.

Weimer, were interviewed and did not object to accepting said proposed new road as a Township Highway; that said proposed new road is now open and used by the general public as a driveway for more than twenty one years; that the existing width of the present road is fourteen (llp!) feet; that the proposed new road is in a built up section of the Township and is of the type commonly known as an Alley and is not an intregal part of a through Route, the location of which is shown in green on the blue print hereto attached and made a part of this report; that after hearing all interested persons present at the view and Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, we find that there is a necessity for said proposed road and proceeded to layout same as follows:
