REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court,  
we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of  
the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respect-  
fully report;

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of  
the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by  
the records of the Court; that having given due public notice  
of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as re-  
quired by law along the route and at the termini of the said  
proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto  
attached, and by service of said notice upon the County Com-  
missioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of Upper Yoder  
Township and the Solicitor of Upper Yoder Township, evidence  
of which is shown by copies of said notice hereto attached  
and made a part of this report; that we met in accordance with  
the notice given on the 14th day of October A. D. 1942 at  
9:30 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our  
appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed  
new road; that during the view, all of the owners of property  
abutting on said proposed new road and the three Viewers were  
present. Objections to the opening and improving of the said  
proposed road were made by John Ober and Frank Hite whose  
properties also abut on Sell Street, an improved Highway. Also  
Frank A. McCallum, whose property abuts on Ruth Street, an  
improved Highway. After viewing the premises and hearing all  
of those who were present at the View, we met at the office of  
S. E. Dickey & Co., 809 Johnstown Trust Bldg., Johnstown, Pa.,  
where two of the Supervisors, namely, Curt Barnhart and D. H.

Weimer, were interviewed and did not object to accepting said proposed new road as a Township Highway; that said proposed new road is now open and used by the general public as a driveway for more than twenty one years; that the existing width of the present road is fourteen (14') feet; that the proposed new road is in a built up section of the Township and is of the type commonly known as an Alley and is not an integral part of a through Route, the location of which is shown in green on the blue print hereto attached and made a part of this report; that after hearing all interested persons present at the view and Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, we find that there is a necessity for said proposed road and proceeded to layout same as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in Orchard Way, a public highway, at the intersection of the center line of Ruth Street with the center line of the proposed new road, known as Orchard Lane; thence by the center line of said proposed new road or Orchard Lane N.  $46^{\circ} 5'$  E., 253.8'; thence N.  $47^{\circ} 35'$  E., 319.06' to the intersection of said proposed new road with the center line of Sell Street, a public highway, the place of ending. The total length of said proposed new road being 572.86'. The exact location of the place of beginning from the nearest intersecting public highway, namely, Derby Street, is at a distance of 574' measured along the center line of Ruth Street (in a Westerly direction from the intersection of said Ruth Street with Derby Street. The exact location of the place of ending from the nearest intersecting public highway, namely, Gomer Street, is at a distance of 728' measured along the center line of Sell Street in an Easterly direction from the intersection of said Sell Street with Gomer Street; that after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that said road as prayed for by the Petitioners and laid out

by us is necessary and convenient for the property owners and the general public and that same will not be burdensome to the taxpayers of Upper Yoder Township. Therefore, we recommend that the prayer of the Petitioners be granted and that the width of said proposed new road or Orchard Lane be at the minimum width of fifteen (15') feet as established by law, P.L. 1935, Page 745, by taking an equal depth of five tenths (0.5') feet from all of the properties abutting on either side of said proposed road.

A release of damages signed by the abutting property owners was filed with the Petition. We find, however, that said release has not been signed by Frank A. McCallum, John Ober and Frank Hite, however, taking into consideration the benefits to be derived and the damages that may be sustained by the acquisition of said additional land, five tenths (0.5') feet in width on either side of said proposed road, the opening, grading, draining, improving and maintenance of same, we assess no benefits and no damages to said Frank A. McCallum, John Ober, Frank Hite or the owners of any other property abutting on said proposed new road.

"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

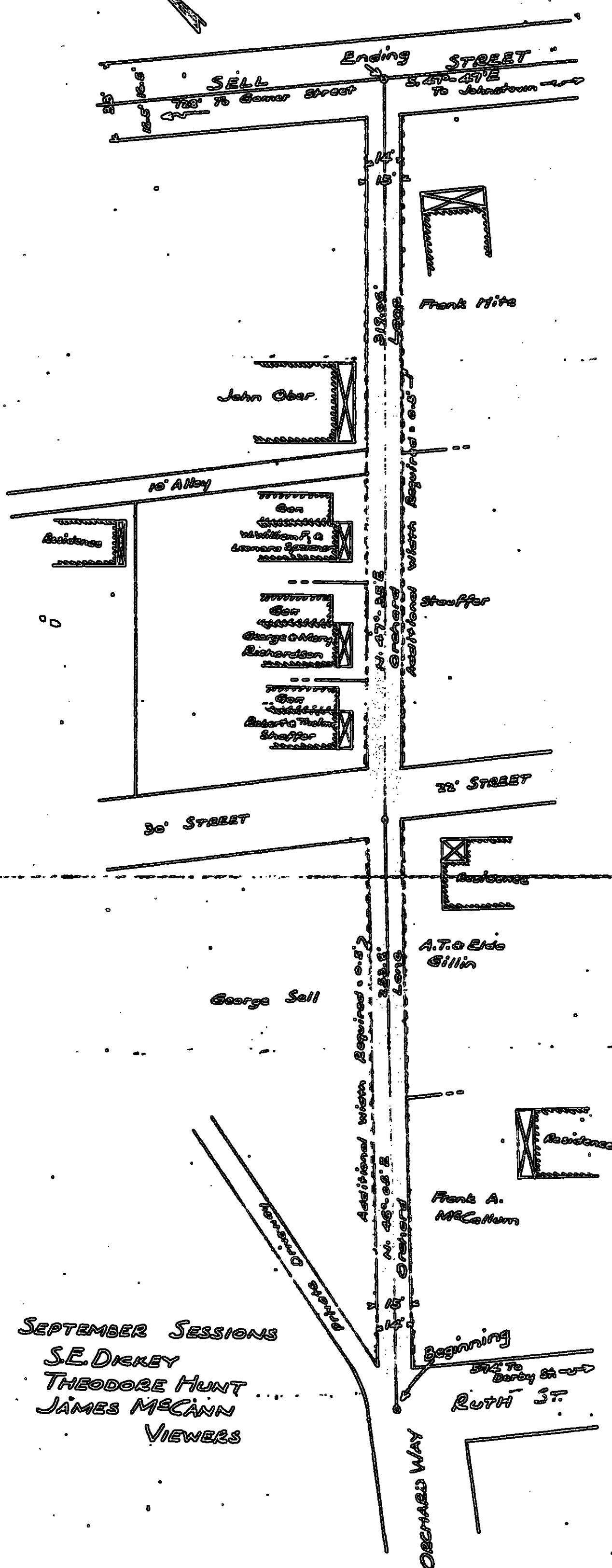
