

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 18th day of January A. D. 1950, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Adams, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a laying out of a new road or highway, to lead from

That they and the citizens of Adams Township labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road in the village of Dunlo beginning at a point on State Highway Route No. 11009 approximately five hundred feet South from the intersection of State Highway Route No. 11009 and the Township Road leading from the village of Dunlo to the village of Sidman and continuing in an easterly direction a distance of six hundred feet to the right of way of the Pennsylvania Railroad running from Sidman to Krayn.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Robert Mayer surveyor, and William McGrain and Fred Claflin

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court,
we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the attached order of the
above Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully
report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of
the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the
records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the
time and place of meeting by posting notices as required by law
along the route and at the termini of said proposed new road, as
evidences by copy of said notice hereto attached and by service
of said notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the
Solicitor for the Supervisors of Adams Township, evidence of which
is shown by copies of said notice hereto attached and made a part
of this report; that we met in accordance with the notice given
on the 11th day of February, A. D., 1950, at 10:30 o'clock a.m.,
E. S. T., and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and
viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road; three (3)
property owners and the Supervisors of the Township appeared and,
we are of the opinion, that a necessity exists for the proposed
new road, that the grades are acceptable, and the alignment is
straight, all according to attached blueprint. Beginning at a
point on Pennsylvania State Highway Route No. 11009, approximately
500 feet south from the intersection of State Highway Route
No. 11009 and the Township Road leading from the village of Dunlo

to the village of Sidman; thence South 52 degrees 10 minutes East, a distance of 576 feet to the westerly line of Lot No. 219, this road being 25 feet wide. Said road being 576 in length as shown on the attached blueprint colored in green and made a part hereof.

In view of the absence of any interested parties at the site of the View, a hearing was called in the offices of Gray & Claflin, Consulting Civil Engineers on Wednesday, March 1, 1950, and at this hearing Mr. Joseph B. Valko, President of the Adams Township Supervisors, and Mr. Charles Bender, and Mr. Joseph G. Valko, the other two supervisors were present, offered no objections to the taking over of this road by the Township.

That after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that the road as prayed for by the petitioners and viewed by us is necessary and convenient and will not create an undo hardship on the Supervisors, therefore we recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted.

We assess no damages and no benefits.

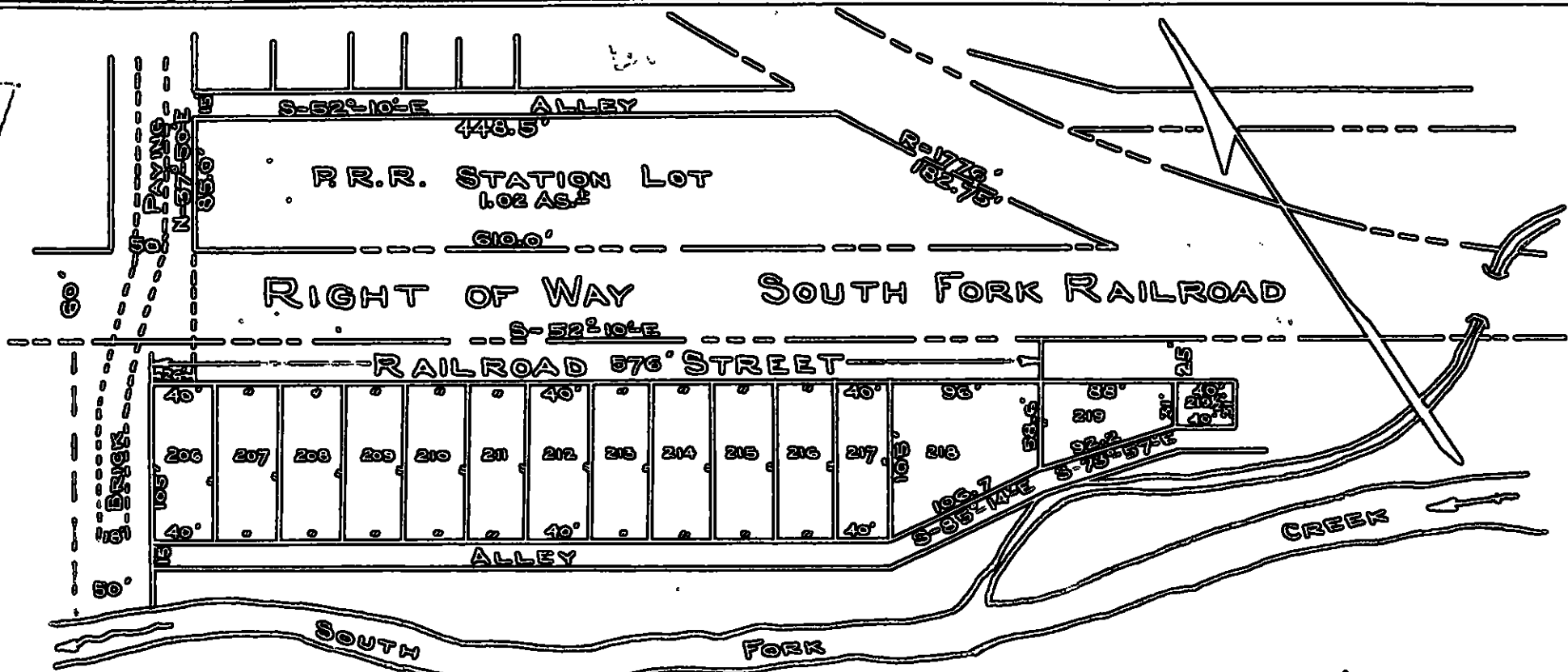
