That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the termini of said proposed new road, as evidences by copy of said notice hereto attached and by service of said notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the Solicitor for the Supervisors of Adams Township, evidence of which is shown by copies of said notice hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met in accordance with the notice given on the 11th day of February, A. D., 1950, at 10:30 o'clock a.m., E. S. T., and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road; three (3) property owners and the Supervisors of the Township appeared and, we are of the opinion, that a necessity exists for the proposed new road, that the grades are acceptable, and the alignment is straignt, all according to attached blueprint. 
