EXCEPTIONS TO THE PETITION AND REPORT OF VIEWERS

The Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll and County of Cambria, State of Pennsylvania, by their attorneys, file the following exceptions to the Petition and report of Viewers in the above stated matter:

-1-

As the contemplated road lies wholly within the said Township of West Carroll, a township of the second class, the provisions of the Act of July 10, 1947, P. L. 1481, 53 P. S. 19093-101 et seq. are applicable and not the provisions of the General Road Act of June 13, 1836, PL 551, 36 PS 1781, as amended. As the proceedings for the laying out of the said township road were instituted under the General Road Act, the return should be set aside and the proceedings dismissed as not being in compliance with the Act of 1947, which superseded the General Road Act insofar as second class townships are concerned.

-2-

The proposed road would benefit very few people in the said Township of West Carroll, and is entirely unnecessary for public use and the construction and maintenance of the road would be very burdensome to the inhabitants and taxpayers of the said township.

Even if the General Road Act were applicable in this case, the petition should be dismissed as being irregular in form and therefore fatally defective in that the termini of the proposed road as defined in the petition vary materially from the termini established by the viewers.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the termini of the said proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached, and by service of such notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of West Carroll Township, the Solicitor for the Petitioners, and the Solicitor for the Supervisors being hereto attached; that we met in accordance with the notice given, on the first day of April, 1950 at 10:30 A.M., D.S.T. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road; the Solicitor for the Petitioners, the three (3) Township Supervisors, and sixteen (16) abutting property owners were present.

On August 18, 1950 at 10:30 D.S.T., a public hearing was held at the site of the proposed road and in the assembly room of the Bakerton Inn. The Solicitor for the Petitioners, one Township Supervisor and twenty-three (23) abutting property owners were present. Testimony was given by the Township Supervisor, Mr. Gladstone Bradford, the Attorney for the Petitioners, Mr. J. Harrison Westover, and three (3) of the property owners.

The starting point of said road begins at a point on State Highway Route No. 11097, which ^{is} 333 feet in a northwesterly direction from the junction of State Highway Route No. 11097 and a public road to Carrolltown and runs, as shown tinted on the attached map, a distance of 3,367 feet to a point on State Highway Route No. 11097, which is 436 feet in a southeasterly direction from the junction of State Highway Route No. 11097 and Pa. State Highway Route No. 11047.

That after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that the road as prayed for by the petitioners and viewed by us is necessary and will not create an undo hardship on the Supervisors of West Carroll Township, therefore we recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted.

We assess no damages to the abutting property owners and no benefits.



REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law along the route and at the terminal of the said proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached, and by service of such notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of West Carroll Township, the Solicitor for the Petitioners, and the Solicitor for the Supervisors being hereto attached; that we met in accordance with the notice given, on the first day of April, 1960 at 10:30 A.M., P.M.T. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road; the Solicitor for the Petitioners, the three (3) Township Supervisors, and sixteen (16) abutting property owners were present.

On August 16, 1960 at 10:30 P.M.T., a public hearing was held at the site of the proposed road and in the assembly room of the Bakerton Inn. The Solicitor for the Petitioners, one Township Supervisor and twenty-three (23) abutting property owners were present. Testimony was given by the Township Supervisor, Mr. Gladstone Bradford, the Attorney for the Petitioners, Mr. J. Harrison Westover, and three (3) of the property owners.

The starting point of said road begins at a point on State Highway Route No. 11097, which ^{is} 333 feet in a northwesterly direction from the junction of State Highway Route No. 11097 and a public road to Carrolltown and runs, as shown tinted on the attached map, a distance of 3,367 feet to a point on State Highway Route No. 11097, which is 456 feet in a southeasterly direction from the junction of State Highway Route No. 11097 and Pa. State Highway Route No. 11047.

That after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that the road as prayed for by the petitioners and viewed by us is necessary and will not create an undue hardship on the Supervisors of West Carroll Township, therefore we recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted.

We assess no damages to the abutting property owners and no benefits.

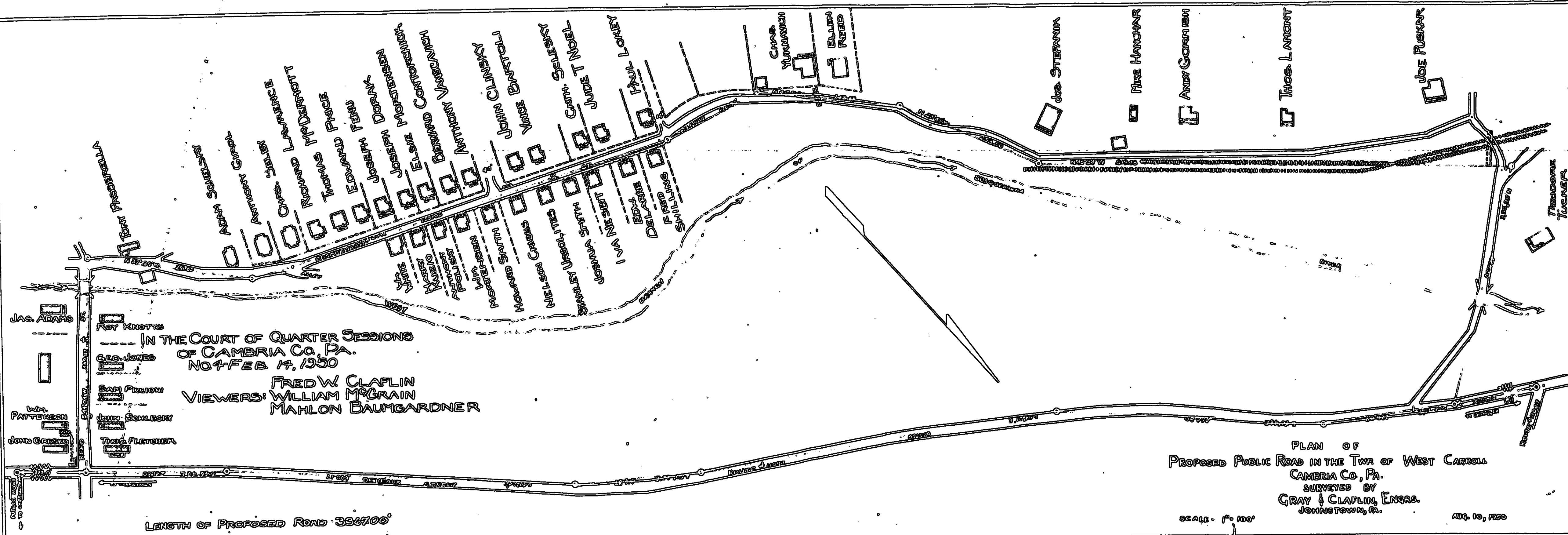
