

IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of the Supervisors of West Taylor Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represent;

FIRST

That the residents and citizens of West Taylor Township owning property and living along a private road running from Cardiff Street to Cooper Avenue have petitioned the Supervisors of West Taylor Township to adopt, take over and open up the said private road as a Township Highway.

SECOND

That the said proposed Township Highway as a proposed Township Right-of-way has been laid out and dedicated to public use for many years by the original Grantors and adjoining property owners, but the West Taylor Township Supervisors have never adopted the same as a Township Highway.

THIRD

That the said proposed Township Highway beginning at a point on Cardiff Street and extending through and along the said private road and the adjoining properties to Cooper Avenue and the Right-of-way granted by the adjoining property owners is forty feet in width and the said adjoining property owners have all signed Releases covering the Right-of-way.

FOURTH

That the Supervisors of West Taylor Township are desirous of adopting the said proposed highway as a Township Highway so as to better serve and meet the needs of the citizens of West Taylor Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

FIFTH

That the said Supervisors of West Taylor Township have passed a Resolution, adopting project as a Township Highway and authorizing this Petition asking your Honorable Court's approval, a certified copy of the said Resolution of the Township Supervisors is hereto attached and made a part hereof as well as a blue print of a survey made by H. J. Bossler together with the Releases of the adjoining property owners.

Therefore, your Petitioners pray, your Honorable Court, to approve the said adoption of the said highway as a Township Highway leading from Cardiff Street to Cooper Avenue and said Right-of-way to be forty feet in width between property lines, and they will forever pray.

A COPY OF THE RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE WEST TAYLOR TOWNSHIP ROAD SUPERVISORS HAD A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD HELD ON JUNE 13, 1950.

Moved by Edwin Miller, seconded by Joseph Cernic that the Township Road Supervisors of West Taylor Township except and take over a Proposed Road leading from Cardiff Street through and along various properties and extending to Cooper Avenue. The said Proposed Right-of-way being the width of forty (40) feet, and the property owners along and through which said highway passes having released the West Taylor Township Road Supervisors of any damages in connection with the construction of said highway. That said Highway has been surveyed by H. J. Bossler, Registered Surveyor, on January 15, 1949, a print of which is on file in the Office of the Township Supervisors. All members voting yea, motion carried.

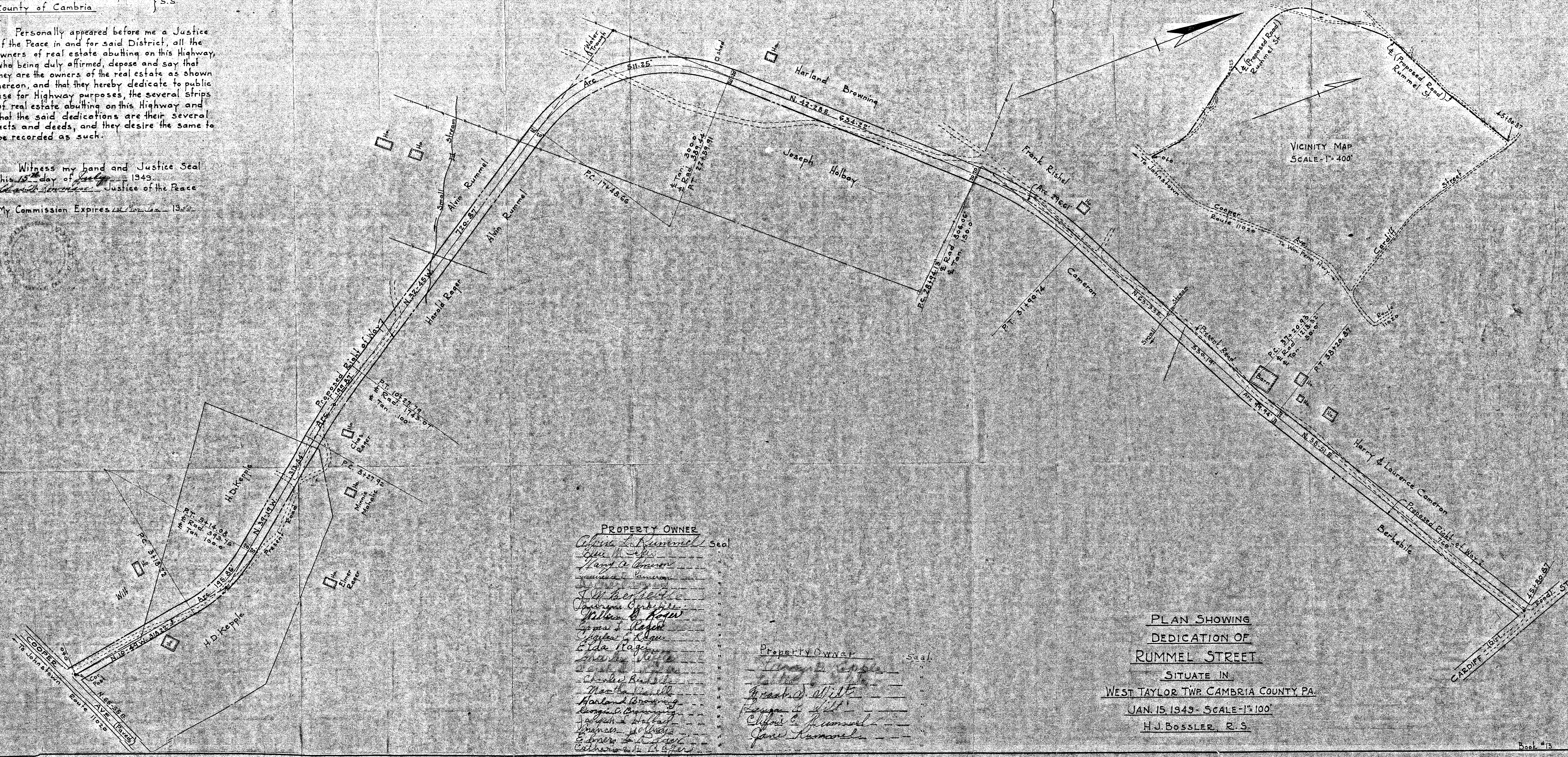
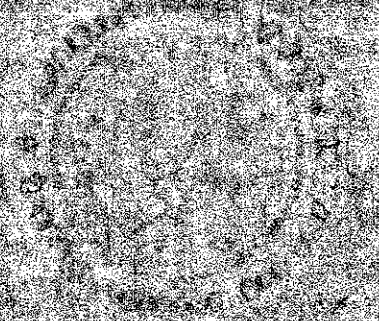
