PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of the Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following
facts:

That at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll, held on the 3rd day of April, 1954, a Resolution was adopted by said board adopting and taking over a certain portion of a road in the Village of Bakerton, Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, a certified copy of which Resolution is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

That the section of road in the Village of Bakerton hereinafter described is shown on the revised plan of lots laid out in the Village of Bakerton as is recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds, etc., in and for the County of Cambria, in Plat Book Volume 4 at Page 65, Section 3, being described as follows:

"That portion of Susquehanna Street beginning at the intersection of road existing between lots 186 and 142 in the hereinafter named plan of lots and continuing to and beyond the intersection of Reed Street to the intersection of unnamed road

located along lots 161 and 177 in the plan of lots laid out for the Bakerton Land and Improvement Company."

A survey showing the above described section of land is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof.

That the section of roadway which is to be adopted and taken over by the Supervisors of West Carroll Township is fully described in the above mentioned Resolution adopted by the said supervisors on the said 3rd day of April, 1954.

WHEREFORE, the petitioners pray your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over and adopting of said roadway as a township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18, 1935, P. L. 1299, as amended and supplemented, in order that such roadway shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of West Carroll.

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT CERTAIN SECTION OF ROADWAY IN THE VILLAGE OF BAKER-TON, TOWNSHIP OF WEST CARROLL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE SAME

On motion of Joseph Brawley, seconded by Bernard Contorchick, and duly passed, it is resolved that we adopt and take over for the purpose of improving the same, by the Supervisors of West Carroll Township, that section of roadway located in the Village of Bakerton, Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, more particularly described as follows:

"That portion of Susquehanna Street beginning at the intersection of road existing between lots 186 and 142 in the hereinafter named plan of lots and continuing to and beyond the intersection of Reed Street to the intersection of unnamed road located along lots, 161 and 177 in the plan of lots laid out for the Bakerton Land and Improvement company."

The said resolution is adopted upon the following conditions:

- (a) That the said roadway can be taken over legally so that the usual highway contribution for maintenance of the same can be received;
- (b) That releases be obtained from each of the property owners abutting on said road releasing the supervisors from any and all damages by reason of the improvement and the necessary widening of the said road according to law.
