

In re: ORDAINING OF STREET § IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS
IN RICHLAND TOWNSHIP § OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

REPORT OF SUPERVISORS
OF
RICHLAND TOWNSHIP

Made this fifth day of June, 1952, at a special meeting of the Supervisors of Richland Township.

WHEREAS, Harry V. L. Hager and Ada W. Hager have petitioned the Supervisors of Richland Township to ordain and accept a certain portion of Brumbaugh Street as shown by the copy of their petition which is attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, aforesaid petitioners are the only property owners affected by the ordaining and accepting of said Street, being the sole abutting owners on said Street, and

WHEREAS, said petitioners have released the Township of Richland from all liability whatsoever as a result of the ordaining and accepting of said Street as shown by the copy of said release attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Supervisors of Richland Township that it is in the best interest of the Township that said Street be ordained and accepted.

THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of Richland Township, hereby make and approve this report in favor of ordaining and accepting the following:

All that certain strip or road in Richland Township, more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the westerly side of Salmon Avenue at the corner of Brumbaugh Street, as marked on the hereinafter mentioned Plan of Lots; thence North 85° 38' West,

a distance of 464.95' to a point at line of land now or formerly of Jacob M. Hoffman; thence South 11° 37' West, a distance of 40', more or less, thence South 85° 38' East, a distance of 470.04' to a point on Salmon Avenue; thence North 4° 22' East, a distance of 40' to a point, the place of beginning.

BEING marked and known as Brumbaugh Street on the Suburban Realty Company Purparts Hilltop Section, Arbutus Park Plan of Lots laid out by Fetterman Engineering Company and dated November 6, 1929 and recorded in the Cambria County Recorder's office in Plat Book Vol. 3, page 69. Being colored red on Petitioners' Exhibit #1, hereto attached.

PETITION TO ORDAIN AND ACCEPT ROAD

To: The Supervisors of Richland Township.

Petitioners hereby Petition the Honorable Supervisors of Richland Township to ordain and accept as a Township Road the hereinafter described road, in accordance with the procedure provided for ordaining and accepting private roads in second class townships by Public Law 1481, Section 15, July 10, 1947, as amended (53 P.S. 19093-1101) and represent as follows:

1. Said road asked to be ordained and accepted is described as follows: ALL that certain strip or road in Richland Township, more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the westerly side of Salmon Avenue at the corner of Brumbaugh Street, as marked on the hereinafter mentioned Plan of Lots; thence North 85° 38' West, a distance of 464.95' to a point at line of land now or formerly of Jacob M. Koffman; thence South 11° 37' West, a distance of 40', more or less, thence South 85° 38' East, a distance of 470.04' to a point on Salmon Avenue; thence North 4° 22' East, a distance of 40' to a point, the place of beginning.

BEING marked and known as Brumbaugh Street on the Suburban Realty Company Parparts Hilltop Section, Arbutus Park Plan of Lots laid out by Petterman Engineering Company and dated November 6, 1929 and recorded in the Cambria County Recorder's office in Plat Book Vol. 3, page 69. Being colored in red on Petitioners' Exhibit 1, hereto attached.

2. Petitioners, Harry V. L. Hager and Ada W. Hager, of Westmont Borough, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, are the sole property owners abutting on said private road, owning all of the property adjoining said road on the North and all of the property adjoining said road on the South, having acquired title to said properties by deeds recorded in the Cambria County Recorder's office in Deed Book Vol. , at page .

3. No other property owners other than the petitioners are affected by the ordaining and accepting of said road.

4. The ordaining and accepting of said road will in no way impose any liability on the Township and will, in fact, benefit the Township.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioners pray that the Honorable Supervisors of Richland Township ordain and accept said road by the following method provided by said law hereinbefore referred to: at your regular meeting make a written report in favor of ordaining and accepting said road, together with a draft of said road and file duplicate copies of such report and draft in the office of the Clerk of Courts of Quarter Sessions. Upon such filing, enact an Ordinance ordaining and accepting said road.
