REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the permanent board of viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the proprietyof vacating a certain piece of public road in East Carroll Township, said county and state; between the terminal points specified in said order; respectfully report:



"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonweach to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be suswined, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, tained, it shall be together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."
