



Sealed with our seals and dated the 20 day of April, A. D. 1923.

WHEREAS, a petition of certain inhabitants and tax payers of the City of Johnstown was presented to the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County on the 22 day of April, A. D. 1923, for the appointment of Viewers to view the premises and take action with respect to the necessity of a public bridge over the Little Conemaugh River, connecting Railroad Street in the Tenth Ward with First Street in the Eleventh Ward of the City of Johnstown.

WHEREAS, in the matter of the petition of the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown for the appointment of Viewers to view the site for a bridge over the Little Conemaugh River, connecting Railroad Street in the Tenth Ward with First Street in the Eleventh Ward of said City, the report of Viewers was filed on the 4th day of June, 1923, and was on the 7th day of September, 1923, submitted by the Court to the Grand Jury, and the Grand Jury having found that the erection of such bridge will require more expense than it is reasonable for the City of Johnstown, a city of the third class, to bear, and the County Commissioners not deeming it advisable to enter such bridge on record as a County bridge, and the Grand Jury having recommended that the County Commissioners furnish the City of Johnstown, out of the County funds, the sum of

## REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court.

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed Order of the above Court, to view the place proposed for the Bridge over the Little Conemaugh River connecting Railroad Street in the Tenth Ward with First Street in the Eleventh Ward of the Gity of Johnstown, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully report:-

That we were duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County as shown by the records of said Court, gave due public notice of the time and place of meeting of said Viewers by publication in the Johnstown Daily Tribune and by handbills posted on the premises and by notices served upon the Commissioners of Cambria County and upon Tillman K. Saylor; Esq., Solicitor for the City of Johnstown, at least ten days prior to the time of the making of the said view, evidence of which is shown by copy of said notices hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met upon the premises according to the notice given on Tuesday May 8th. 1923 at 10:00 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment.

We wiewed the site and locality of the Bridge proposed to be built, making a personal inspection of the grounds at points designated in the petition and order.

We find that the proposed new bridge is to replace the present old bridge connecting Railroad Street in the Tenth Ward with First Street in the Eleventh Ward of the City of Johnstown, County of Cambria, Pennsylvania, which is in bad condition and inadequate for the present traffic, therefore, we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for a bridge to replace the old bridge at this site; that the expense of erecting said bridge of sufficient size to take care of the present and future traffic would be burdensome upon the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown and that said expense is greater than the City of Johnstown is able to bear, therefore, we proceeded to lay out said bridge having due respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for the same and in such manner as would be as near as practicable to the desire of the petitioners and at the same time do the least injury to private property, a plot or draft showing the location of said proposed bridge is hereto attached and made a part of this report. The terminii of said proposed bridge being shown in said draft.

We gave due consideration to the matter before usuand we are of the opinion that there is a necessity for the said bridge as laid out and further that the expense of erecting same would be burdensome upon the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown and more that it is reasonable they should bear and that the bridge is necessary for the traveling public, therefore, we recommend the proper assistance by the County of Cambria.
