TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:-

The petition of GEORGE COLE, JOHN HUGHES,
and Henry Lauer ~~HOVER~~ Supervisors of Dean Township,
in said County and State, respectfully represents:-

That it is desirable and advantageous to
change a portion of the route of a certain Public Road in said
Township, more particularly described as follows:- Beginning at
a point on the State Highway leading from the Buckhorn to Ashville,
to a point on the State Road, leading from Ashville to Dysart,
through the property of the Big Four Coal Co., the distance on
said road, proposed to be changed, being about seven hundred (700)
hundred feet, as more particularly described in the draft hereto
attached and made part of these proceedings.

That a release for damages is hereto attached,
executed by M. J. Kelley, Treasurer of the Big Four Coal Co., and
that the costs of making proposed change will not exceed the sum
of Three Hundred (\$300) Dollars.

Wherefore, your petitioners respectfully
pray that the new location be approved by the court and that the
same be taken and deemed to be the Public Road to all intents and
purposes, and the old location so shown by the draft hereto at-
tached, shall be taken and deemed to be vacated.

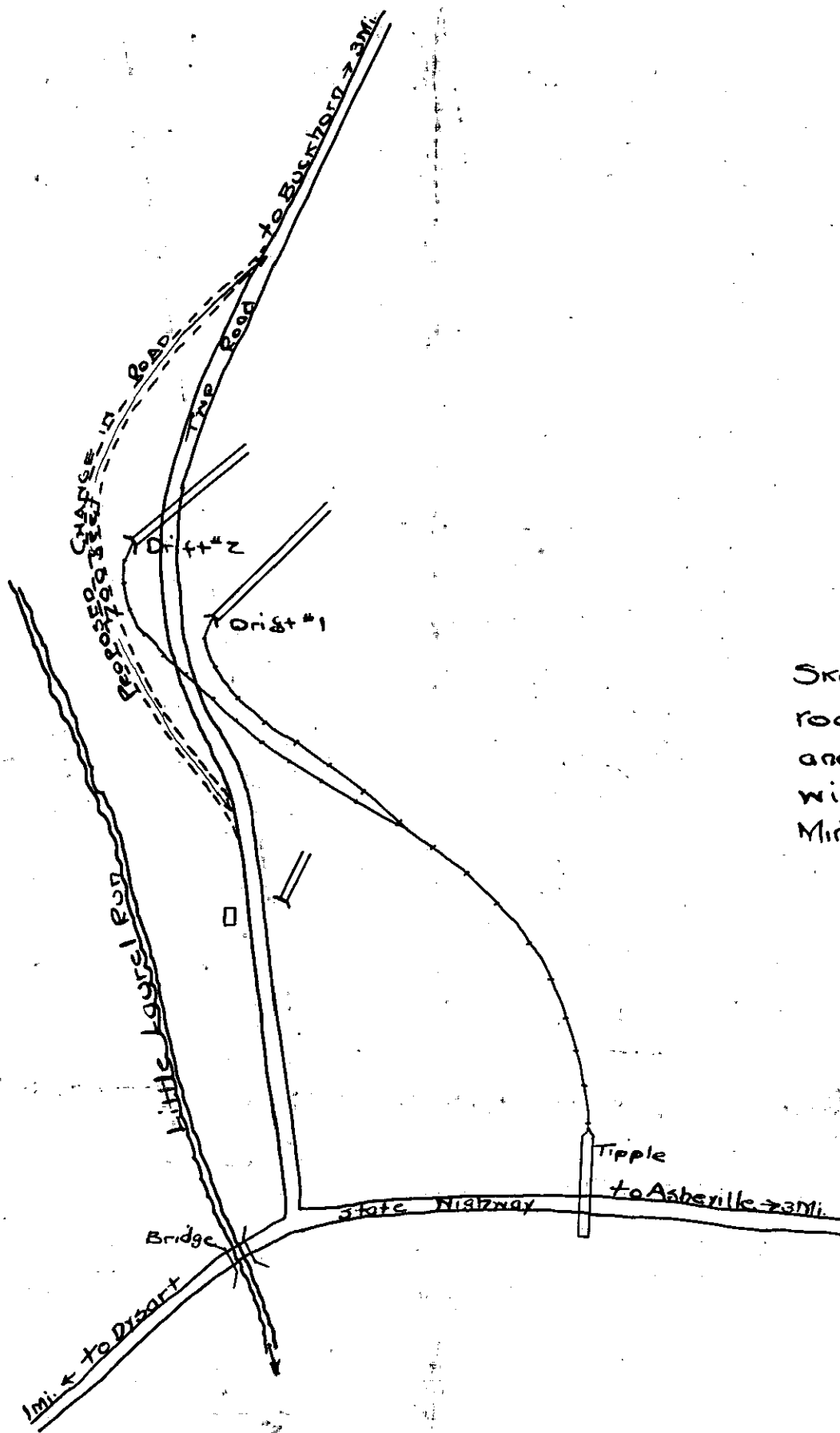
NOW, 14 day of ^{NOVEMBER} October,
