REPORT OF VIEWERS

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED COURT:

WE, the undersigned Viewers appointed by the order of the above Court to view the proposed bridge site over the Conemaugh River between the Borough of East Conemaugh and the Borough of Franklin, Cambria County, Pa., respectfully report:

That we were duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent board of viewers as shown by the records of the Court, that due public notice of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers was given by publication in the Johnstown Tribune and by notices posted along the site of the proposed bridge, copies of these notices being attached hereto, at least ten days prior to the time of making the said view.

That we met on the site of the proposed bridge on the 11th day of July, A. D. 1922, at ten o'clock A. M., and we proceeded with the duties of our appointment.

That we investigated the cost estimate of the proposed bridge and the nature of the traffic passing over the said bridge.

That we held a hearing on the 15th day of July, A. D. 1922, at ten o'clock A. M., in the Board of Viewers Chambers in Johnstown and we heard evidence relative to the plans and cost of the proposed bridge and the nature of the traffic to be thereon.

That we were of the opinion that the proposed bridge is situate on State Highway Route No. 52 and is used as a main highway from the City of Johnstown to points North in the County and is used by the public of the County to such an extent that it is a necessity to County traffic and for this reason we are of the opinion that the entire cost of the construction of the bridge should not be paid entirely by the Borough of East Conemaugh but the cost should be borne jointly by the County of Cambria and the borough of East Conemaugh.
