

To the Honorable; the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County.

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the Township of Chest, Cambria County and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully represents: That they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road to begin at a point on the Patton and St. Lawrence road, 13,750 feet North East of the intersection of the Thomas Mills road with the Patton-St. Lawrence road; thence North sixty two degrees ten minutes East; 970 feet to a point on Patton-St. Lawrence: road, 1015 feet South West from intersection of Coalport and Westover roads with Patton-StLawrence road, in the said township. The petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three persons; qualified according to law, to view the ground proposed for such road, and if they see occasion to law out the same, to inquire of and vacate the public road now openedifrom a point on the Patton-St. Lawrence road 13700 feet. North East of the intersection of the Thomas Mills road with said Patton-St. Lawrence road; thence North eighty egrees East six hundred and sixty feet to a post; thence North thirty one degrees fifty five minutes East three hundred ninety feet to a posint on Patton-St. Lawrence road, ten hundred fifteen Bet. South West of intersection of Coalport and Westover road with said atton-St. Lawrence road, on the line of the the proposed road in the said Township of Chest; which said last mentioned section of road will; by reason of the laying out of the proposed road, become useless. REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating and supplying certain portions of a township road in Chest Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, between the terminal points specified in said order; which is hereto attached; respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of the Township of Chest and having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminii of the road to be viewed, and having all been duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: All of us met in accord with the notices so given as aforesaid and having carefully viewed the premises are all of the opinion that the portion of road beginning at a point on the Patton-St. Lawrence road 13,750 feet North East of the intersection of the Thomas Mills road with said Patton-St. Lawrence road and extending thence North 80° East 660 feet and North 31° 55' East 390 feet to the other termini mentioned in said above referred to order, should be vacated, and that instead of the portion of road recommended to be vacated a piece of road beginning at the same point 13,750 feet North East of the intersection of the Thomas Mills road with the Patton-St. Lawrence road and running thence North 62° 10' East 970 feet to the North Easterly termini of the piece of road proposed to be vacated should be supplied instead of that vacated.

A plot or draft showing the portion of road proposed to be vacated as well as that proposed to be supplied is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

The Viewers having failed to obtain a release of damages from John Hricko, through and over whose land the piece of road as laid out and herein recommended passes, have assessed his damages at One Hundred Dollars.

"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefily the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
